Regular Council Meeting
Monday, March 23, 2026

With a quorum present, Mayor Eddie Ford called the City of Jenkinsburg's Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Attending were Mayor Eddie Ford, Mayor Pro-Tem Jason Watts, Council Members: Gary Brown, Gary Roberts, Brent Eberspacher. Joye England arrived at 7:12. City Clerk Debi Smith also was in attendance.

Intergovernmental agreement concerning Burg Road - A motion was made by Jason Watts to approve and adopt the intergovernmental agreement to re-surface Burg Road as presented with the following amendment. Chapter three shall read as follows. Whereas, the County has approved a project to re-surface Burg Road, which partially extends into the City limits. The term “which is a municipal street” is to be removed. The motion was seconded by Gary Brown.
