Regular Council Meeting
Monday, April 27, 2026
Minutes

With a quorum present, Mayor Eddie Ford called the City of Jenkinsburg's Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Attending were Mayor Eddie Ford, Mayor Pro-Tem Jason Watts, Council Members: Gary Brown, Gary Roberts, Brent Eberspacher and Joye England. Debi Smith also was in attendance.

Adopt Agenda: - A motion was made by Gary Roberts to adopt the agenda for the March 23, 2026, meeting. The motion was seconded by Jason Watts. Council voted: Jason Watts – aye, Brent Eberspacher– aye, Gary Brown – aye, Gary Roberts – aye, Joye England – aye. The motion passed.

Gary Brown gave the invocation and Mayor Eddie Ford led the pledge to the US Flag.

Approve Minutes from April 13, 2026: - A motion was made by Gary Brown to approve the April 13, 2026 minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Jason Watts. Council voted: Jason Watts – aye, Brent Eberspacher– aye, Gary Brown – aye, Gary Roberts – aye Joye England-aye. The motion passed.

Appointment to Municipal-County board of elections and Registration of Butts County: - A motion was made by Jason Watts to appoint Chris Foster to represent the City of Jenkinsburg on the Municipal County Elections Board of Butts County for a term of April 27, 2026 through August 20, 2029 for the unexpired term of David Burford. The motion was seconded by Brent Eberspacher. Council voted: Jason Watts – aye, Brent Eberspacher– aye, Gary Brown – aye, Gary Roberts – aye Joye England-aye. The motion passed.

Derrick Adams-Discuss Water Ordinance: A motion was made by Brent Eberspacher to amend JBGO-07-05 City of Jenkinsburg Water use procedures Sec. 1-10(b) to clarify account service termination procedures relating to deceased account holders. The motion was seconded by Jason Watts. After a brief discussion, Brent Eberspacher made a request that his motion be withdrawn. With no objections the motion was withdrawn with no further action taken. It was then agreed upon that the Council would review the existing water use ordinance and take further action and amendments as appropriate and necessary.
