Regular Council Meeting
Monday, February 23, 2026
Minutes

With a quorum present, Mayor Eddie Ford called the City of Jenkinsburg's Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Attending were Mayor Eddie Ford, Mayor Pro-Tem Jason Watts, Council Members: Joye England, Gary Brown, Gary Roberts, Brent Eberspacher and City Clerk Debi Smith.

Adopt Agenda: - A motion was made by Gary Roberts to adopt the agenda for the February 23, 2026 meeting. The motion was seconded by Jason Watts. Council voted: Jason Watts – aye, Joye England – aye, Brent Eberspacher– aye, Gary Brown – aye, Gary Roberts - aye. The motion passed.
