# **Opening Prayer**

**Scripture text: Matthew 4:18** "As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen.

**John 1:40** "Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus.

**1 Corinthians 1:12** "What I mean is this: One of you says, "I follow Paul"; another, "I follow Apollos"; another, "I follow Cephas"; still another, "I follow Christ."

### Things to know:

- Simon Peter was the brother of Andrew
- Peter-The Greek form of the Aramaic surname Cephas
- Simon Peter was known as a friend, disciple and Apostle
- His mother's name was Jonah-John 21:15
- Simon Peter was naturally impulsive-Matthew 14:28, 17:4 John 21:7
- Simon Peter was tender-hearted and affectionate-Matthew 26:75, John 13:9, 21:15 17

#### Other Character traits of Simon Peter

- Gifted with spiritual insight-John 6:68
- Sometimes slow to grasp deeper truths-Matthew 15:15-16

- Courageous in his confession of faith in Christ, yet guilty of denial-Matthew 16:16,
  John 6:68-69, Mark 14:67.....Mark 14:67-71
- Self-sacrificing yet inclined towards self-seeking Matthew 19:27
- Presumptuous at times-Matthew 16:22, John 13:8
- Immovable in his convictions-Acts 4:19-20, 5:28-29, 40 and 42
- He was restored back to Jesus after His resurrection and recommissioned John
  21:15-17

- 3. How can our Character flaws be used to glorify God?

- 6. What makes you a disciple Jesus can use?
