Opening Prayer

Scripture text:

Luke 6:15 "15 Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Simon who was called the Zealot,"

Acts 1:13 "¹³ When they arrived, they went upstairs to the room where they were staying. Those present were Peter, John, James and Andrew; Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew; James son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James.

New Vocabulary:

Zealous- To show great energy or enthusiasm for a cause; being enthusiastic in chase after a cause

Zealot-A historical Jewish political group that rebelled against the Roman Empire,

Canaanite-A person who is from Cana a village in Galilee near Nazareth

Things to know:

- Simon wanted to be free from human rule
- Those who were considered Zealots were hated by other religious groups
- There was a level of independence that the "Zealots" marveled in

• Be who you are that is the person Christ will use to draw others.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is your spiritual temperature?
- 2. What does it mean/look like to be a "lukewarm" Christian?
- 3. How can we bring our "Whole" self to Christ?
- 4. What are some behaviors that hinder spiritual growth?
- 5. How can the Christian be "Free" of the world? It possible?
- 6. What are some behaviors that will strengthen your walk with Christ?
- 7. How can the disciple be an example to others?

Challenge of the week:

Ask God to show you an area of your life that has been more influenced by the world than His eternal Word, bring your whole self to the cross. Confess, Repent, and do no more.

Reflection Moment: As a disciple of Christ, you have a story to share, a heart to touch, and a soul to win for Christ. We serve the God who calls into existence the things that do not exist **-Romans 4:17**
