Opening Prayer

Scripture text: Psalm 15: 1-5

Lord, who may dwell in your sacred tent?

Who may live on your holy mountain?

2 The one whose walk is blameless,
who does what is righteous,
who speaks the truth from their heart;

3 whose tongue utters no slander,
who does no wrong to a neighbor,
and casts no slur on others;

4 who despises a vile person
but honors those who fear the Lord;
who keeps an oath even when it hurts,
and does not change their mind;

5 who lends money to the poor without interest;

who does not accept a bribe against the innocent.

Whoever does these things
will never be shaken.

Things to know:

- When we have clean hands and a pure heart, we can stand before the Lord without guilt
- Taking advantage of another person's misfortune is unholy and not of God or His children
- Love and kindness should flow from the heart not the hand
- Children of God are called to protect one another in the days of evil.

Challenge of the Week:

1 Peter 5:6-7 “Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time He may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on Him, because He cares for you.

Isaiah 41:13 "For I, the LORD your God, hold your right hand; it is I who say to you, 'Fear not, I am the one who helps you.'"
