Matthew 10:3 “³ There were Philip and Bartholomew and Thomas. There was Matthew, the man who gathered taxes. There were James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus,

Mark 3:18 “¹⁸ The others were Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus, Simon the Canaanite,

Things to know:

- Thaddaeus meaning Breast, One that Praises or Man of heart.
- One of the twelve apostles of Christ.
- Thaddaeus was known by the following names: Labbeus or Lebbeus.
- He is the least known of the apostles.

Discussion Questions:

Challenge of the Week: Give a hat, a pair of socks or gloves to someone in need and offer to pray with them (Follow the Holy Spirit)

Reflection Moment: Each time we pray with another person were inviting the Spirit of the Living God in the midst of the two. His word says ” ²⁰ *For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.* ” **Matthew 18:20.** Salvation, healing, and deliverance takes place in prayer. Prayer is FREE, offer it.
