Scripture text: Matthew 10:3 “³ Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James, son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus;”

Mark 3:18 “¹⁸ Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot”

New Vocabulary:

Evangelist- A “Good Newser” one who shares the good news of Jesus Christ to others with the primary goal of winning souls.

Missionary- A person sent on a religious mission, especially to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Gospel- The message of the Life, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ and the message of Salvation which can only be obtained through Faith. The four books of the New Testament are known as the “*Gospels*” named after Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Things to know:

- Phillip was a native of Bethsaida in Galilee
- Name means: Warrior or lover of horses

- Phillip traveled with Nathanael as a companion and introduces him to Jesus
- Jesus found Phillip, Phillip wasn't looking for Jesus-John 1:43
- Phillip brought others to Christ
- Phillip was tested by Christ- John 6:5. He failed the test.
- Phillip was tested a second time John 12:21-22
- Phillip was slow to understand some biblical truths John 14:7-9
- Phillip was an evangelist, and missionary to Samaria and the Ethiopian Eunuch-Acts 8:26-40.

Discussion Questions:

1. What have you noticed about Philip?
2. Can you identify as a missionary or an evangelist?
3. Have you shared the love of God through the resurrection power of Jesus Christ this week? If not, what stopped you?
4. How did Phillip's life change by walking with Jesus?
5. Why is it necessary for believers of Christ to be followers of Christ? What is the difference?

Reflection Moment: *Walking with Jesus will change the way we See, Hear, Think, and Respond. Jesus came to give sight to the blind, open the ears of the deaf, renew the mind of lost and create a new heart in those that will believe.*

Faith in Action:

- Read your Bible for 15 minutes a day
- Set an alarm on your phone to pray at a set time and protect that time.
- Reach out to a loved one and invite them to Worship with you.
- Make time to be available to witness to someone about the Love of God and the forgiveness that comes through receiving Christ as Lord and Savior.
