Topic: A call to Worship and Obedience

Welcome

Opening Prayer

Scripture text: Psalm 95:1-11

Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord;

let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.

2 Let us come before him with thanksgiving

and extol him with music and song.

3 For the Lord is the great God,

the great King above all gods.

4 In his hand are the depths of the earth,

and the mountain peaks belong to him.

5 The sea is his, for he made it,

and his hands formed the dry land.

6 Come, let us bow down in worship,

let us kneel before the Lord our Maker;

7 for he is our God
and we are the people of his pasture,
the flock under his care.

Today, if only you would hear his voice,
8 “Do not harden your hearts as you did at Meribah,
as you did that day at Massah in the wilderness,
9 where your ancestors tested me;
they tried me, though they had seen what I did.
10 For forty years I was angry with that generation;
I said, ‘They are a people whose hearts go astray,
and they have not known my ways.’
11 So I declared on oath in my anger,
‘They shall never enter my rest.’”

Things to know:

- God desires that we obey and worship Him
- We are to sing joyfully to the Lord for He is good
- God loves all that He has made, mankind is special to God
- The Hebrew word for Psalms is *tehilim*, which means praise.

-The book of Psalms shares with us the relationship between God's activities in the lives of His people and their responses to Him.

1. What makes it "hard to sing" and "shout joyfully" to the Lord"?

2. Why does mankind fight for such power? Is there anything not touched by God Vs3-4
3. What are the limits of mankind? Vs 5
4. What should be the response to our Creator? Vs6-7
5. What are some causes of rebellion against God? Vs 8-9
6. What did God do to the rebellious? For how long? Was God just in His decision? Vs 10
7. What rest are believers promised?
