Rahul slams govt over...

Calling it a "failure of basic governance," Gandhi alleged that the poor were left to suffer in deteriorating government hospitals while quality medical care was restricted to the wealthy. "Public hospitals have become unsafe and private hospitals are out of the reach of the majority. Is this the model of governance the BJP is proud of?" he questioned.

Gandhi demanded strict accountability and justice for the families, saying, "How can the government claim to govern effectively if it cannot ensure the safety of newborn children?" The two infants admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) of MY Hospital were bitten by rats earlier this week. Despite treatment, both died within 24 hours. Hospital officials said the babies were already in a critical condition due to congenital complications, but the presence of rodents inside the NICU has raised serious concerns about hospital hygiene and management. The state government has suspended two nursing staff, removed the nursing superintendent and fined the pest control agency responsible. A high-level inquiry has also been ordered into the incident.

Not a single MP varsity...

Education experts blame the state's poor showing on weak research output, scant international collaborations, and fragile industry linkages, all of which continue to hold back Madhya Pradesh's institutions while peers elsewhere race ahead.

The NIRF rankings, based on teaching, research, graduation outcomes, inclusivity, and perception, once again underline an uncomfortable truth — Madhya Pradesh's higher education system is struggling to keep pace with national standards, with just a handful of institutions holding the line against a tide of mediocrity.

Manipur peace hopes

Front (UPF), which together represent 23 underground outfits — aims to maintain Manipur's territorial integrity, ensure the free movement of goods and people along National Highway-2, and relocate militant camps away from vulnerable areas. According to the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), the re-negotiated ground rules include strict physical verification of cadres by security forces to weed out foreign nationals, relocating weapons to nearby CRPF and BSF camps, and reducing the number of designated camps. A Joint Monitoring Group will oversee compliance, with violations potentially triggering a review of the SoO agreement. Officials said the pact has been extended for one more year and is expected to create a more secure environment for dialogue. "The KNO and UPF have abjured the path of violence and agreed to abide by the Constitution, the laws of the land, and Manipur's territorial integrity," the MHA said.

The Kuki-Zo Council (KZC) has also announced that it will open NH-2 for the free movement of commuters and essential supplies — a key demand of valley-based Meitei groups, who had alleged that militants used blockades to cut off the Imphal Valley. The KZC said it would cooperate fully with central forces to maintain peace along the crucial highway.

The SoO agreement was first signed in 2008 but had lapsed in February 2024 amid worsening ethnic strife. Its renewal is being seen as a confidence-building measure between the warring communities.

Putin kavach for Modi...

He noted that large countries like India and China have unique political systems and domestic laws, warning that attempts to "punish" them place their leaders in a difficult bind. "If one of them shows weakness, his political career will be over," Putin said.

Speaking of history, he reminded the West of its colonial past. "Countries have had difficult periods in their history, such as colonialism, attacks on sovereignty for prolonged periods of time. Now that the colonial era is over, they have to realise that they cannot use this tone in speaking with their partners," he said.

Putin's remarks come against the backdrop of intensifying trade and geopolitical tensions, particularly amid US tariffs.

The Post reported that with the relationship between the United States and India at its lowest point in decades, Washington's inflammatory language toward New Delhi is deepening the crisis and complicating efforts to repair ties.

Peter Navarro, one of President Donald Trump's longest-serving and most trusted advisers, has gone on the attack, making increasingly charged statements about India and Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Russia's conflict with Ukraine is "Modi's war," Navarro further described New Delhi as a "laundromat for the Kremlin," and said that Indian "Brahmins are profiteering" from the conflict, an apparent reference to a Hindu caste.

The Post said one of the people familiar said the centerpiece of the Greer proposal was an Indian offer to significantly reduce its tariffs on U.S. goods, which would represent a major concession from New Delhi in the countries' long-running trade dispute. Trump, however, has declined to approve trade deal options unless India commits to scaling back its purchases of Russian oil.

US pulls India tariff gun...

Ukraine. In court papers, it insisted that tariffs are "a crucial aspect of our push for peace" in war-torn Ukraine.

On August 27, the Trump administration doubled tariffs on India to 50% — half imposed to penalise New Delhi for ramping up Russian oil imports after Moscow's invasion of Ukraine, and the other half under Trump's "America First" push to cut trade deficits.

The government warned that striking down the tariffs would expose the US to trade retaliation and undercut efforts to secure peace abroad. "We recently authorised tariffs against India for purchasing Russian energy products to deal with a preexisting national emergency regarding Russia's war in Ukraine," the administration wrote, adding that removing them "would thrust America to the brink of an economic catastrophe."

Sauer told the justices, "The stakes in this case could not be higher," urging them to preserve the duties that a lower court had found unlawful. "With tariffs, the US is a rich nation; without tariffs, a poor nation," the filing declared. "According to Trump, one year ago, the US was a dead country, and now, because of the trillions of dollars being paid by countries that have so badly abused us, America is a strong, financially viable, and respected country again." The administration argued that the tariffs were bolstering the defense-industrial base, safeguarding USD 1.2 trillion in annual trade deficits, and reinforcing foreign negotiations.

YAMUNA SWELLS PAST 207 METRES IN DELHI: The water level in the Yamuna river at Delhi's Old Railway Bridge stood at 207.47 metres at 9 am, even as floodwater from the raging river continued to inundate nearby areas and relief camps. According to official data, the level remained steady between 6 am and 7 am at 207.48 metres. While the level at 5 am stood at 207.47 metres, it stood at 207.48 metres at 6 am. HIMACHAL: Thirty-five ailing & elderly Manimahesh Yatra devotees were airlifted from Chamba in Himachal Pradesh by a helicopter in seven sorties on Thursday despite adverse weather conditions, the state government said. It said that in a major operation launched by the Chamba administration to safely evacuate devotees, nearly 500 devotees were rescued in vehicles from Bharmour to Chamba. At certain stretches where roads have been damaged, adequate security personnel have been deployed.

SC ASKS REPLIES FROM CENTRE, NDMA, AFFECTED STATES

Considering the unprecedented landslides and flooding in states like Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand, the Supreme Court on Thursday sought the stand of the Centre, National Disaster Management Authority and others, and observed "illegal felling of trees led to the disasters". Observing a balance ought to be struck between "development and environment", a bench of Chief Justice B R Gavai and Justice K Vinod Chandran also issued notices to the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, the National Highway Authorities of India (NHAI) as well as the governments of Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jammu and Kashmir and Punjab. "We have seen unprecedented landslides and floods in Uttarakhand, Himachal & Punjab. From the media reports it is noticed that in the flood a huge number of wood was flowing along. Prima facie it appears that there has been illegal felling of trees. Thus issue notice to respondents," CJ said.



SRINAGAR: Police rescued and evacuated nearly 200 families from flood-affected areas of Srinagar district as flood fears in rest of the valley eased slightly following receding of water level in Jhelum on Thursday. "In response to the ongoing flood-like situation and heavy waterlogging in various parts of the city, Srinagar Police, in close coordination with SDRF and River Police, has activated a comprehensive evacuation and relocation plan to safeguard the lives and well-being of affected citizens," police spokesperson said.

GUJARAT has received widespread rainfall this monsoon, with an average of 92.64 per cent recorded across the state till Thursday, according to the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC). North Gujarat has reported the highest rainfall at 96.94 per cent, followed by South Gujarat (96.91 per cent), East-Central Gujarat (93.79 per cent), Kutch (85.14 per cent) and Saurashtra (84.74 per cent). The heavy and uniform rainfall has significantly filled up reservoirs.

LACK OF FUNCTIONAL CAMERAS

SC takes suo moto cognisance of CCTV cameras in police stns

The Supreme Court on Thursday registered a suo moto case over the lack of functional CCTV cameras in police stations across the country.

A bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta took cognisance of a media report stating that 11 people have died in police custody in Rajasthan during the first eight months of 2025.

According to the media report, police often do not provide CCTV footage in custodial death cases, and many police stations have remand rooms outside the cameras' view.

The police gave various reasons for withholding CCTV footage, including technical faults, lack of storage,

ongoing investigations, or legal restrictions, while in some cases, they simply refused to share the footage or delayed its release.
