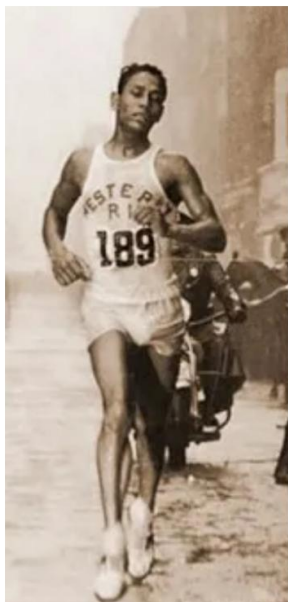

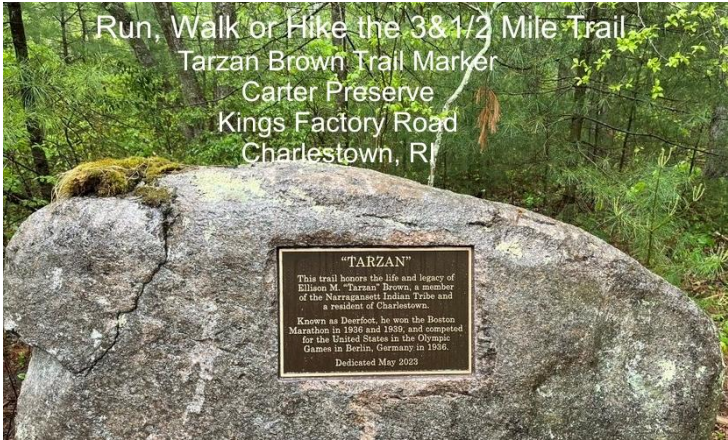
Opening Ceremony Welcome and Introduction
