
**"8:00 a.m. Friday, March 21 #Update:** Since 6:30 a.m., we have been actively removing materials and clearing the slide area. Updates will continue throughout the day, including after our 8 a.m. coordination meeting with the Statewide Emergency Operations Center.

**Landslide experts are arriving this morning to assist with assessment and planning for ongoing debris removal. Our focus has been on the north side, and once significant progress is made, we will shift efforts to the south side."**
