



PUBLIC NOTICE – 04/23/25

DOT&PF Wolfe Point Slope Stability Improvements

Traffic Advisory:

04/24/25 – Two lane traffic through Wolfe Point Bypass with intermittent short delays from 8:30am -4pm while construction work is occurring.

Blasting Notice:

There will be a blasting event on Thursday April 24th between 9am-3:30pm at Wolfe Point – 4418 Tongass Avenue between MP 3.0 & 3.2. Expect 15–20-minute delays in traffic during the blasting event.

At the time of the blast, Flaggers will be stationed at the road closure point to ensure no unauthorized entry.

The following blast signals will be sounded on an air horn:

- Blast warning signal- A series of 5 (five) long signals, 5 minutes prior to blasting.
- Blasting imminent: A series of short signals 1 (one) minute prior to blast.
- All clear signal: One (1) long signal following the inspection of the blast area.

Safety Reminder

- Speed limit is 20 mph
- No pedestrian or bicycle traffic access through the bypass during this time

Please follow all posted signs for speed limits, detours, and lane changes. Thank you for your patience!
