



Hog Wild Precision LLC (HWP) NICS Denial / Delayed Policy

- It is the policy of Hog Wild Precision LLC (HWP) to hold all firearms on a NICS responses **of Delayed or Denied**. Many times, this is related to same or similar name/DOB as a prohibited person, old arrest with no conviction, expunged or sealed record not updated in databases, rights restored but not reflected, incorrect felony/misdemeanor classification, and/or an old protective order that expired. A denial **does not automatically mean** you're prohibited. It does mean that HWP will not transfer the firearm(s) that you purchased until after the appeals process.
- HWP will hold your purchase for 90 days while you navigate the appeal process. Appeals typically take 2-8 weeks. There is no storage cost to you for this 90-day hold. However, at the end of the 90 days, we expect the appeal process to be completed, and you should have already received a written decision. If that decision is to proceed, we will transfer your purchase to you. However, if it remains denied or if we don't hear from you at or before 91 days, HWP will take possession of your purchase and resell the item.
- To appeal a denial or delay, you must have the NICS Transaction number, your full name, Date of Birth, Place of Birth, and Social Security Number. The SSN is optional but helps to reduce mistaken identity issues. To find the reason for denial or delay status and links to file your appeal electronically go the following URL:
