## Treasurer Report (Cindy)

- Review current balances (as of 12/11/21)
  - Checking = \$488.44
  - Savings = \$16,860.36
  - Total = \$17,348.80
- One new resident paid dues
- Last mowing in November; Sam Smith agreed to keep us as a client for 2022
- Budgeted for Biggs Landscaping but not used; Retain for potential emergency services and maintenance
- Doug motioned to accept proposed 2022 Budget; Joan 2<sup>nd</sup> motion; All attendees agreed w/ 'aye'

# Membership Report (Linda)

- 2021 Membership Dues paid by 57 of 80 residents/property owners = 71.3% (77.5% in 2020, 77.5% in 2019, 70.9% in 2018)
- Several Members generously donated an additional \$1125 w/ their Dues

## 2022 Budget Recommendation

- Recommend we retain Membership Dues and Slip Dues at 2021rates for 2022
- Increase amount for Insurance (rate increase) and Enhancements expenses; Ramp to boat dock needs work, possibly replacing (consider new marine-grade material, wider, new footers, etc.); Handrail needs to be replaced; Price-out aluminum ramp; Ask Mark McCool about a new ramp
- Do holes in pilings where dock structure was raised need to be filled to prevent rotting? Ask Mark McCool for recommendation
- Website How many views? Linda will investigate

## 2022 Membership Dues Recommendation

- Currently \$150 (\$100=2015-2019, \$150=2020-2021)
- Recommend we retain \$150 for 2022

## 2022 Slip Lottery and Dues Recommendation

- Currently \$6750 for 9 slips (1=\$650, 2=\$700, 2=\$750, 4=\$800); \$100/year increase for 3 years (2019-2021)
- Recommend we retain 2021 Slip Dues for 2022

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## Slate for 2022 Board of Directors

- All current Board Members offered to return for 2022 Ed Oceanic (President), Don Ruth (Vice President), Cindy Hamilton (Treasurer), Linda Gaydos (Secretary), John Lytwynec, Joan Skloot, RoseMarie Tate, Doug Uhl (Members-at-Large)
- Recommend we add 2 more Members-at-Large positions (up to six) based on other resident's desire to be involved; Linda will distribute new By-Laws wording to Board for approval to be voted on by Membership prior to Annual Meeting

# Boat Dock Expansion Potential

- Delay any further potential boat dock expansion until 2024-2025
- Post at top of Boat Dock access road will be moved toward pond to widen area, and to prevent driving around
  post to avoid chain
- Determine whether bollards preventing vehicles crossing dam at pond can be moved 2-4 feet toward Boat Dock to provide more maneuverability for boat launch
- Add bollard to middle of Beach access road to prevent pick-up trucks and trailers from entering Beach area; Only golf-cart type vehicles will be allowed at beach

## **Community Maintenance and Improvement Plan**

- Ed ordered Barley Straw for pond to deploy in Spring may help control algae
- Liriope Hill community vs Biggs Growing Solutions clean-up? Add to Spring Clean-up activities
- Boat Ramp improvement/maintenance cut, cloth, stone (6", 2", crush & run), redesign, move bollards
- Investigate adding bulkhead to Beach to prevent boat launching; Talk w/ MDE
- Boat dock access road improvement perf-pipe & stone, rent excavator @ \$500 (total cost = ~\$6K?)
- Trail access around pond Doug will talk w/ Bob Hodge; Investigate landscaper removing cleared brush
- Need more zip ties for piling protectors; Linda will order

## **Community Sign Replacement**

- Joan contacted county no new permit needed unless illuminated or substantial change in size (42'x24')
- Move sign to vacant lot between first house and airfield; Flag-style sign to allow easy mowing around/under sign; Flag-style sign (~\$4K) w/ event announcement section below

## Storage Racks Sticker System

- Property owner (Bob Hodge) doesn't want personal watercraft laying on ground around racks
- Consider conducting a Rack Lottery for spaces; Consider limiting number of spaces per household to 2; Should we continue w/ 2021 sticker system trial, and if so, needs to be enforced

## **Beach/Picnic Area and Tables**

• Clean-up; Purchase 2 new resin picnic tables and remove all existing wood tables (auction-off to residents?)

# Shorewood Rd Vehicle Speed

- Don speed test activated w/ and w/out sign from 10/5-10/12 on Shorewood Rd; Data not as granular as initially thought; Overall, recorded typical speeds 25-35mph; 15mph advisory speed is too slow
- Initial 30mph speed at beginning of Shorewood Rd from Wilson Point Rd seems OK; Suggest changing speed to 20mph instead of 15mph before curve and thru neighborhood
- MD State speed on residential county roads = 25mph; Don will pursue changing speed w/ Kent County

- Shed doors May need to install trim and stopper to close tighter (Doug will investigate)
