The Nativity Game

This engaging build a Nativity game is perfect for Christmas fun. Play it to review and retell the story of Jesus birth. Turn it into a craft by using the black and white version as a color and paste activity after playing the game for double fun. Create craft stick puppets for retelling and extend the game into a writing activity for older students.

It can also be used with any flash cards, task cards, or word cards. Increase retention by having students create their own review cards for any subject. Students answer a review card correctly in order to spin.

How to Assemble Game Boards

You will need a background scene for each player. Print the game picture boards (pages 5-6) onto heavy card stock. Laminate for added durability. You will need 1 spinner board. Print page 3-4 on cardstock and laminate.

Print 4 copies of the character cards on page 7-8 so each player has enough cards to finish their scene. You can easily make these into file folder games or store them in page protectors and create a game notebook.

Craft Activity

After playing the game, turn this into a fun craft activity. Students can use the black and white version to color, cut the characters out and create the nativity scene. For this activity each student will need a copy of pages 5 and 8, crayons, scissors, and glue.

Make craft stick puppets and let the children retell the story. Provide a copy of page 7 or 8, 10 craft/popsicle sticks, crayons, scissors, and glue for each student. Have students color and cut out the characters. Glue to the top of a craft stick.

Students can also use their completed scenes to write a summary of the events or other topic based on the nativity story.
