Turning Pain Into Purpose Our Story

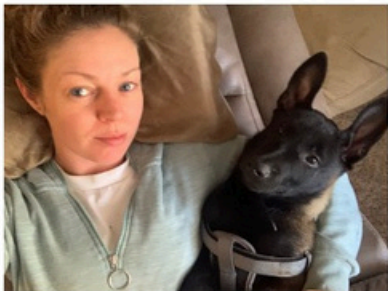
Rebekah's Legacy was born out of unimaginable loss.

In March 2021, our daughter filed a Personal Family Member Assault charge against her husband and made the courageous decision to leave.

On July 20, 2021, she returned alone to retrieve personal belongings. That same day, she and her dog went missing.

Ten and a half months later, a body was discovered.

We believe she was murdered.
