

2025 GoLeaf Golf League Summary

This is a quick overview of our Golf League. It is intended to give a quick summary to help you decide if you would like to join our league or not. More in-depth league rules are provided on our website or feel free to email info@thegoleaf.com with any questions you may have before you make a decision.

How to Join

- Registration open now until April 15th!
- Visit thegoleaf.com or click [HERE](#) for the registration form.
- Share this with close friends you believe may enjoy the league.

Requirements

- Must have **both** WhatsApp and The Grint apps for the league.
- Must have active handicap that you keep updated in The Grint.
- Must understand this is a for fun league and intended to remain that way.
- Must inform the Secretary of play before starting your round.
- Must keep track of strokes, penalties and putts for scoring and tie-breakers.
- Must read the expanded rules before the season begins.

Monthly Play

- League year lasts from May-September.
- Players must complete 6 rounds of golf from **May-August** at designated courses around the Denver metro area.
- The seventh round of the season will be included in our end of season golf tournament.
- You can play any of the courses you want on the approved list and with anyone that is in the league.
- You may NOT play by yourself.
- We keep score using The Grint so everyone can see your score and the Secretary will keep track of positioning for seeding and earnings throughout the season and each round.

Beginning and End of Year Tournament

- An optional round of golf (weather permitting) will occur the first weekend of May, the format will be scramble and intended for members to meet.
- The End of Year End Tournament will happen the first weekend in September.
- It will be a 2-day event (optional 3-day) with Saturday being the final round of the year so everyone knows the stakes at place, and we can crown the winner then and there.

Additional Information

- 20 or less players - one pool of players.
- If over 20 players - two tiers that will be based off of handicaps; The top 10 will be in the top tier.
- The top tier will be the lower handicaps and lower tier the higher handicaps.
- You only compete against people in your tier to help keep everyone competing for seeding and prize money. You can still play with people outside your tier.
- Gross score (which The Grint calculates for you) will be what is used to determine winners and seeding.

Compensation and Fees

- There will be a yearly fee and monthly fees paid to the Treasurer that will total \$300 for the year.
- You can pay up front or pay over two separate due dates.
- Money all goes into a pot to be won at the end of the season in a step-down reward.
- We also take \$25 out of everyone's dues for a Hole-In-One Pot.
- Side betting between the people you are playing with each round is allowed, but it is on your own and between just the people you are playing with that round.
