Problem Statement and Proposed Project

Margibi County was not spared the 14 years of civil conflict that devastated the country, leaving lives and property damaged, especially the public infrastructure. Moreover, the two deadly viruses – Ebola then COVID19 - came simply to add up to the existing records of out-of-school populations. These children unfortunately end up in involving themselves or participating in anti-social or criminal activities.

Unfortunately, there is a great unmet demand for programs that offer skills, assets, and supports for the youth of Unification City to obtain a stable source of income through both self-employment in the informal and the formal sector. Kolu Sokodolo Children Foundation highly value education and livelihoods as their top goals and priorities.

The community ICT center and Library project aims to support the development of human capital by providing quality technical and vocational training necessary to support economic growth in all sectors of the community economy and that of the country as a whole. This project will serve as a vocational training system to deliver up-to-date training courses, to under-served youth, relevant to the requirements of enterprises operating in the country.

The project seeks to achieve but not limited to the following outcomes:

1. To acquaint the community's youth with ICT tools,
2. To improve the social well-being of children from the targeted communities,
3. To eliminate or lessen Child labor of all forms as a result of the lack of adequate educational facilities.
