He acknowledged the importance of that and promised to consider this. I'm confident that God's word does not return void. Pray for Dr. Huang's salvation.

Now I'm in the Nashville VA transplant center for one final evaluation before I undergo my bone marrow transplant. Through your faithful prayers a doner has been found with a 100 percent match through the Be the Match program.
