For the next several months while in an out of the Houston VA hospital, I pray God help me to be aware of the opportunities to minister and witness to a variety of doctors and nurses, and anybody else he has crossing my journey through this present circumstance. And this he has already done.

I've had the opportunities to pray with doctors before spinal chemo injections and even council with anesthesiologist after bone marrow extractions. One doctor, after a procedure asked me if I had some advise for him or the other doctors and nurses in the room concerning life. I was able to not only to share with them God's plan for life but how they can be prepared for death and eternity as well. Praise God. So for the present moment God has me involved in a special mission to a different group of people. He is also reminding me a few most important things about life and what matters most.

Medical missions results: The medical missions in November was a success. Plans were adjusted to focused in on disaster relieve for those affect by the hurricane that impacted around 80 percent of Acapulco. The medical team treated over 300 patients. 2 ½ tons of cloths were distributed, and 140 adults and 38 kids received Christ.
