The first day we entered we were able to share the gospel which most of them had heard for the first time. Needless to say they received the Word and several accepted Christ as their Savior. We have since returned and have brought Bibles and continuing to do group Bible studies and we are considering doing discipleship with those interested. Please pray for this new ministry.

The Bible club that we hold in the poorest area of the town is going great. A mother decided to stay during the class time and showed much interest in hearing the gospel.
