Feeling Blessed: Result of our Medical Missions Trip

I believe there is a song that goes, "I am counting every blessing, He's so good to me." Coming down from the mountains that is how I felt counting every blessing from the goodness of our God. Once again we treated over 1000 people and over 600 lined up to come through our soul winning clinic where we deal with mental, emotional, social and most importantly the spiritual needs of these people. This time we dealt with those who also spoke the Tlapeneco dialect through interpreters. Again, I also had the privilege to speak and share the gospel with the police that accompany us into the mountains. They accepted Christ and we were able to provide Bibles for them as well. Of the over 600 that passed through the soul winning clinic, over 400 were saved, which among these 400 was the president of the community and his family. At times we can be so saturated and other times, like in the late afternoons we may have fewer coming through our area. This time I had more help in the soul winning clinic so when we had some breathing room, I asked for volunteers to come with me and help relieve some workers in the dental area who had been washing instruments the whole time. I've worked in that area, and it is very challenging at times. The dentists and the dental workers were very appreciative that others would come and help out. A number of the dentists do not know Christ as their savior, so it was a good testimony for them to see. What a blessing to minister not only to the people we go to serve, but to those who come to serve. It was also a blessing to have my son come along who works as an assistant to dentists.
