Two months in a Row: Part One This last trip to the mountains on our medical mission trip to Guerrero was among one of the longest but most fruitful trips we've been on. The doctors attended over 1000 people in four days. Some decided to go early to be able to attend all that were expected to

come. This decision was made at the last minute, so I was unaware until I arrived in the city where we were to leave from. I decided to go with them early and they were right. In the end I had over 800 people pass through the soul winning clinic with <u>over 600 making professions of faith</u>. I also had the privilege of being present with patients through operations and counsel ones whom some thought were demon possessed. We saw many lives transformed including 8 police officers who escorted us to the mountains and back. Four pastors are doing the follow up, praise God.

Two months in a Row: Part Two

Near the end of the year, we had a spontaneous request to use our mobile medical dental unit for a mini medical campaign. The request was made by a church we started at a special educational school. We were able to take the unit out for the first time since it was built. It functioned great and a good number of people were treated. We also were able to find out things we needed to make it more effective in the future. There were other medical services offered as well and we also had the opportunity to share the gospel. Among the 20 plus that accepted Christ at this campaign was a 94-year-old man. I had just sat down and started talking to him about his background. When he was a child he was a dairy farmer as I was. That allowed us to make a good connection and ultimately we got to talking about the God who sends the rain and sun to grow our crops. I commented that this same God wants to also communicate directly with us and have a personal relationship as well. One thing led to another, and the man wanted that personal relationship in his life as well and accepted Christ into his heart. Praise the Lord you are never too old to receive Christ. Praise God for the dental trailer as well. We look forward to utilizing it many more times this year.
