Alpine Heights HOA Residents:

We are working to renew our National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Certification as a Firewise Community in 2026. By following the Firewise guidelines listed on the AHHOA website you ensure that your property is protected to the maximum extent possible. The information we collect on the work performed by contractors and homeowners ensures our Certified status thru 2026-2027. The ability to maintain insurance on our homes also requires that we Firewise our property.

To maintain our Firewise Community status the Alpine Heights community needs to show that we spent approximately \$8,750.00 as a community (\$35.00 per household) on Firewise expenses in 2026. This includes property landscape maintenance, brush and debris clean up, tree trimming and tree removal during the 2026 calendar year. The combination of our individual Firewise efforts and the expense for our community brush pick up will meet this requirement, but the information must be collected and submitted. Please collect your information throughout the year and make our final submittal complete and accurate.
