Foreword

The Global Social Prescribing Alliance Playbook 2026 builds on the vision set out by global leaders in September 2015 at the United Nations General Assembly, when the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) were adopted with the ambition to “Leave No One Behind.”

Focusing on Good Health & Wellbeing (SDG 3), this playbook provides an implementation framework to create ethical, scalable platforms that enhance citizens’ health and wellbeing while strengthening existing public services.

It is designed for system leaders, policymakers, clinicians, community organisations, and international partners leading the implementation of social prescribing globally through the Global Social Prescribing Alliance.

The 2026 Playbook captures this journey and provides leaders with the implementation framework to scale impact even further ensuring communities everywhere can thrive and that no one is left behind.”



Social Prescribing is a holistic approach connecting people to non-clinical community services “prescribing a life, not just medicine.” Types of social prescribing include:

Green – Nature-based activities for mental & physical wellbeing (e.g., community gardening, nature walks, forest bathing).

Blue – Water-based activities for health benefits (e.g., wild swimming, coastal walks, river mindfulness).

Arts & Culture – Creative engagement to support emotional health (e.g., art classes, music therapy, theatre, museum visits).

Physical Activity – Tailored movement and exercise (e.g., walking groups, yoga, swimming, dance).

Social & Community – Reducing isolation through connections (e.g., friendship clubs, volunteering, peer support).

Mental Health & Wellbeing – Non-clinical mental health support (e.g., mindfulness, meditation, resilience workshops).

Work & Skills – Building confidence, skills, and purpose (e.g., job clubs, mentoring, skills workshops).

Practical Support – Assistance with daily challenges affecting health (e.g., housing, debt advice, food banks).

The key points for implementation are outlined in seven foundational steps:

1. Bring Everyone Together to Build Social Prescribing Locally

Successful social prescribing begins with collective leadership.

This requires:

- All local partners working together
- Health systems, local authorities, and voluntary sectors aligned
- Co-production with communities most impacted
- Building on existing community assets and services

A whole-system approach ensures sustainability and trust.

2. Community Development & Support for Local Community Groups

Strong communities are the foundation of social prescribing.

Key actions include:

- Mapping community assets
- Identifying service gaps
- Investing in grassroots infrastructure
- Providing sustainable funding models
- Supporting voluntary and social enterprise sectors

Investment in communities drives prevention and resilience.

3. The Role of the Social Prescribing Link Worker / Community Connector

The Link Worker sits at the heart of effective delivery.

Their role includes:

- Providing time to listen
- Understanding “what matters” to the person
- Using a personalised care approach
- Connecting individuals to community support
- Strengthening community resilience

They act as the bridge between clinical systems and community ecosystems.

4. Create Shared Plans with the Person (Personalised Care Approach)

Social prescribing is deeply rooted in Personalised Care.

A co-produced support plan should include:

- What matters to the individual
- Relevant community connections
- Expected outcomes
- Self-management actions
- Personal and community assets available

This ensures dignity, ownership, and empowerment.

5. Training & Workforce Development

Workforce investment is critical.

This includes:

- Formal Link Worker training
- Accredited learning programmes
- Informal peer networks
- Clinical supervision structures

Training should also extend to referring agencies so they:

- Understand the Link Worker role
- Recognise appropriate referrals
- Support integrated working

6. Ensure Clinical Engagement

Clinical buy-in is essential for scale.

This requires:

- Training clinicians to identify suitable patients
- Embedding referral pathways
- Multidisciplinary collaboration
- Establishing Clinical Champion Schemes

Clinical champions help raise awareness and unify system partners.

7. Measure Impact

Robust evaluation ensures credibility and investment.

A standardised framework should measure:

- Health outcomes
- Wellbeing improvements
- Service utilisation
- Economic value

The National Health Service in England has developed a Social Prescribing Common Outcomes Framework to support consistent data collection and reporting.

To embed social prescribing into mainstream care.

3. Creating Innovative Community Development

Focusing on:

- Existing community assets
- Place-based partnerships
- Sustainable financial structures
- Long-term economic models

4. Implementing the Building Blocks for Social Prescribing

Including:

- Referral systems
- Governance frameworks
- Partnership infrastructures
- Commissioning pathways
