

Out-of-Pocket Costs

Thank you for choosing Puget Sound Spine and Sports Medicine. Our practice does not participate with commercial health insurance plans, so we want to ensure you have the information you need to be prepared for out-of-pocket costs associated with receiving care here. (Please note, if you have an active motor vehicle or worker's compensation claim, we will bill your claim for your care.)

Below, we have provided a list of estimated costs for common appointment types and procedures. (Please note, prices are subject to change.) We offer a 20% discount for paying on the date of service.
