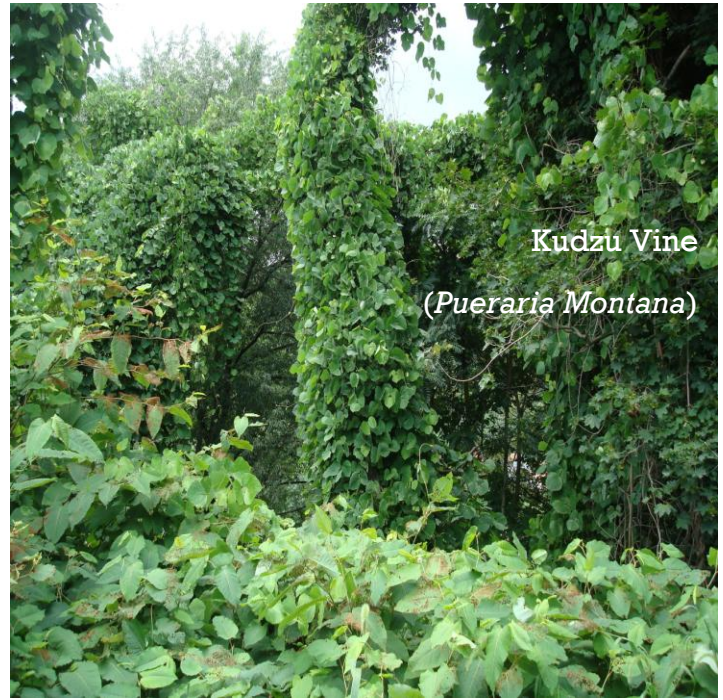

Components of the Juniata CWMA:

1. Prioritized blueprint for dealing with terrestrial and aquatic weeds within the entire watershed
2. Initial support provided by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation: Pulling Together Initiative, USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Foundation for Pennsylvania Watersheds, and REI
3. Unique landscape-based, species-inclusive early detection and rapid response
4. Predictive modeling
5. 50% public awareness
6. Quantifiable prevention
7. Educational curriculum
8. Demonstration sites
9. Service learning
