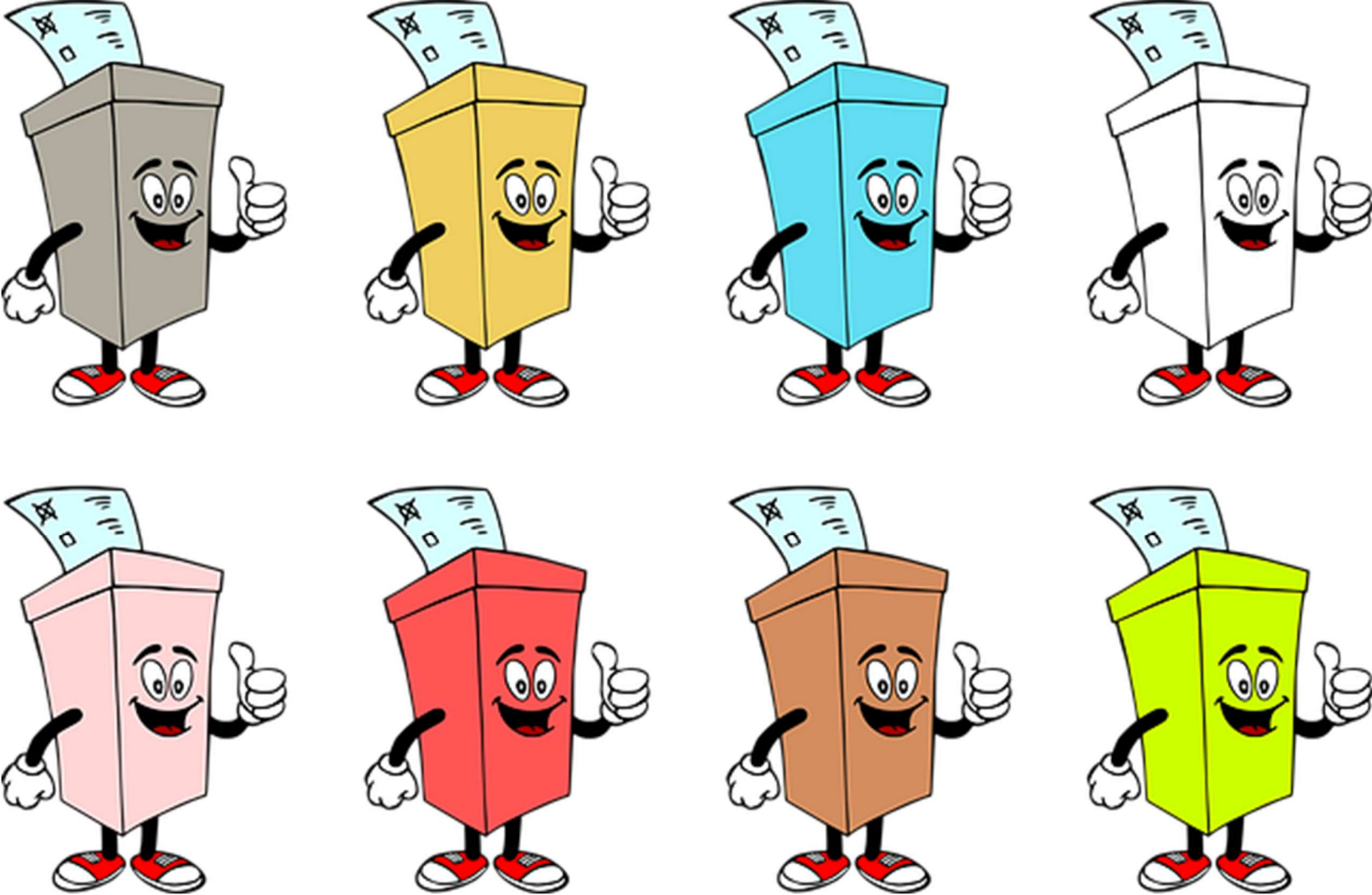

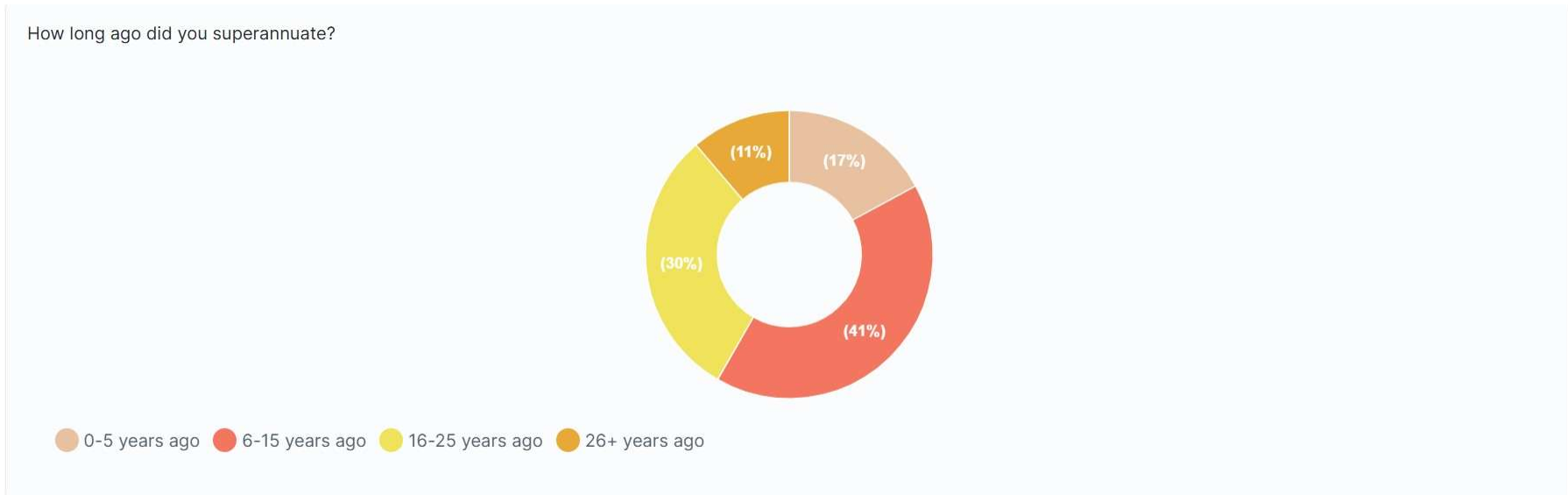

Note: There were 188 responses captured electronically, 4 of which were completely blank with responses and as result, did not contribute to the display charts below.

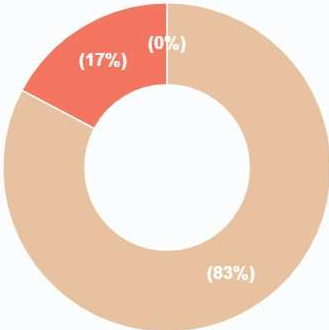

What best describes your interest in Regina Chapter?

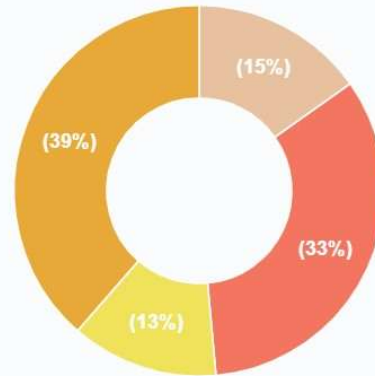


EMAIL Communications from Regina Chapter

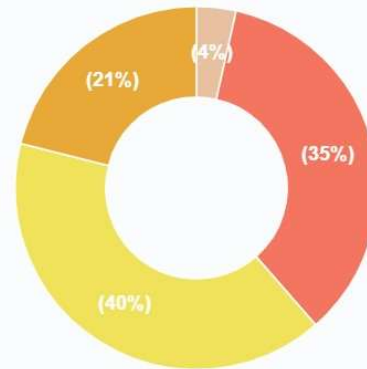


- I read all email communications from Regina Chapter.

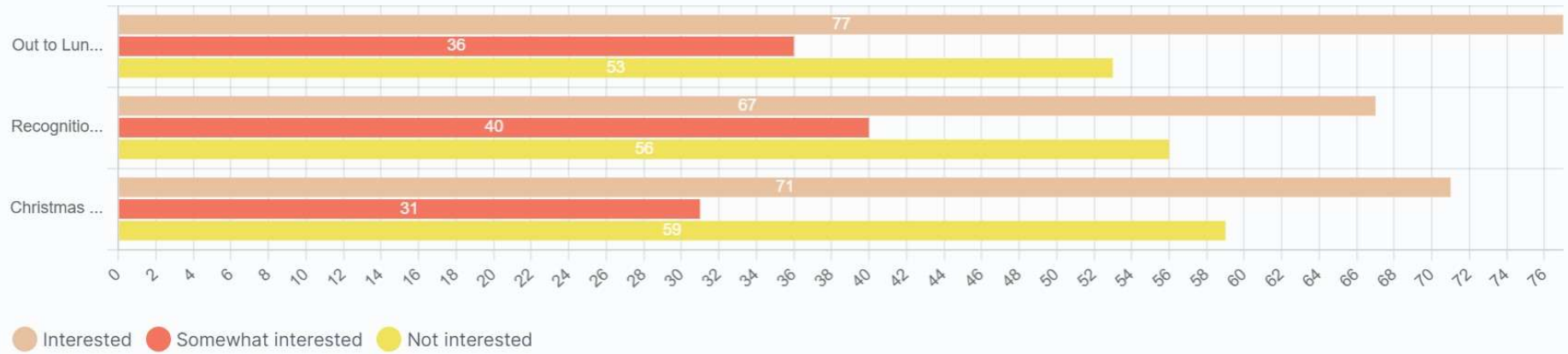
- I am a member of the Regina Chapter Facebook page.

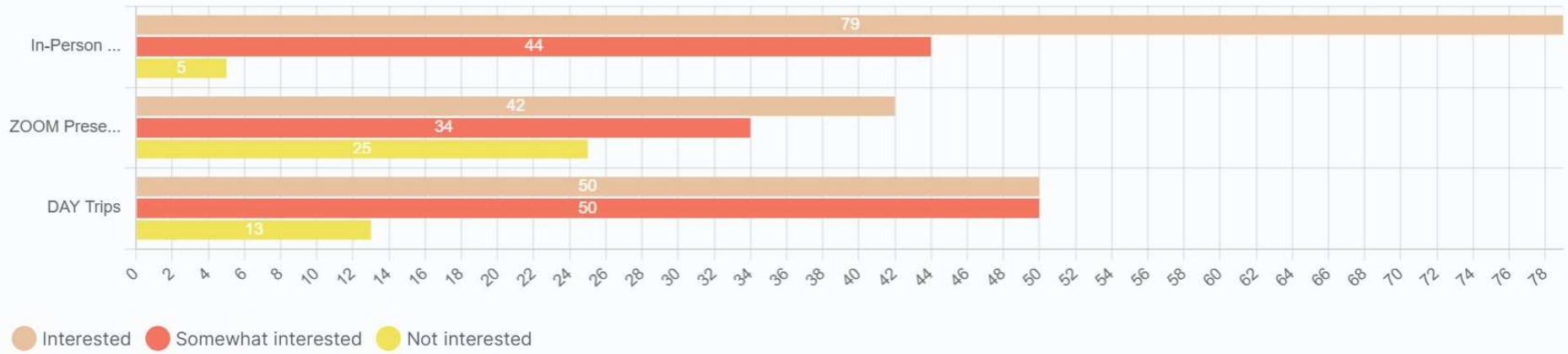

How interested are you in participating in these Annual Events?

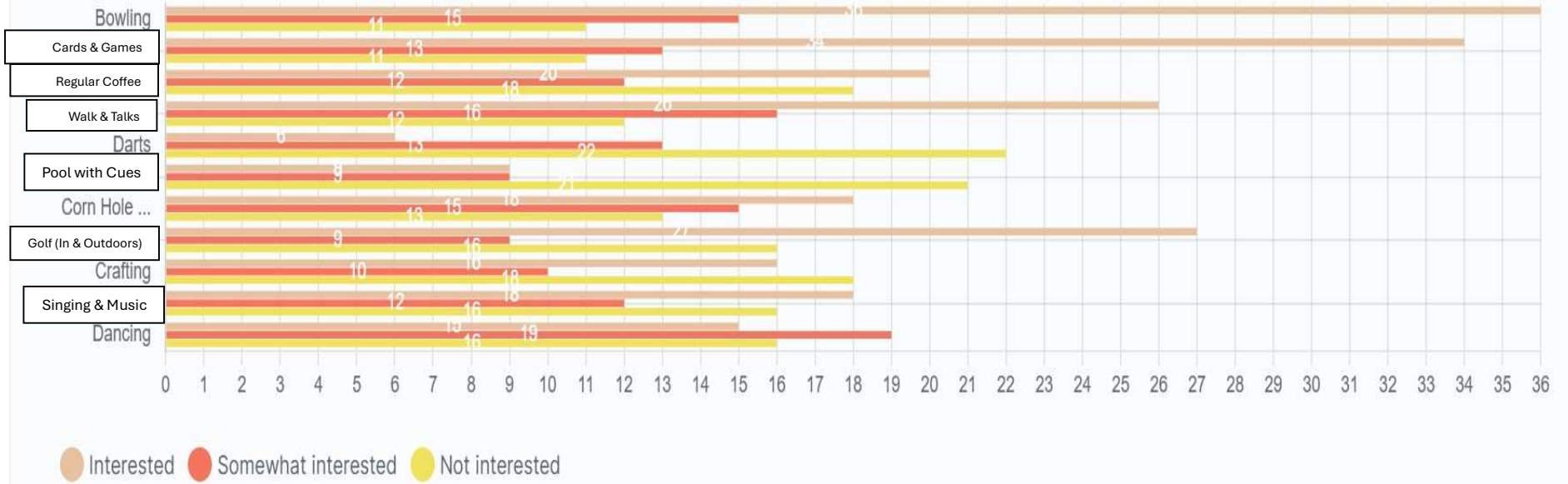


How interested are you in participating in these Learning Events?

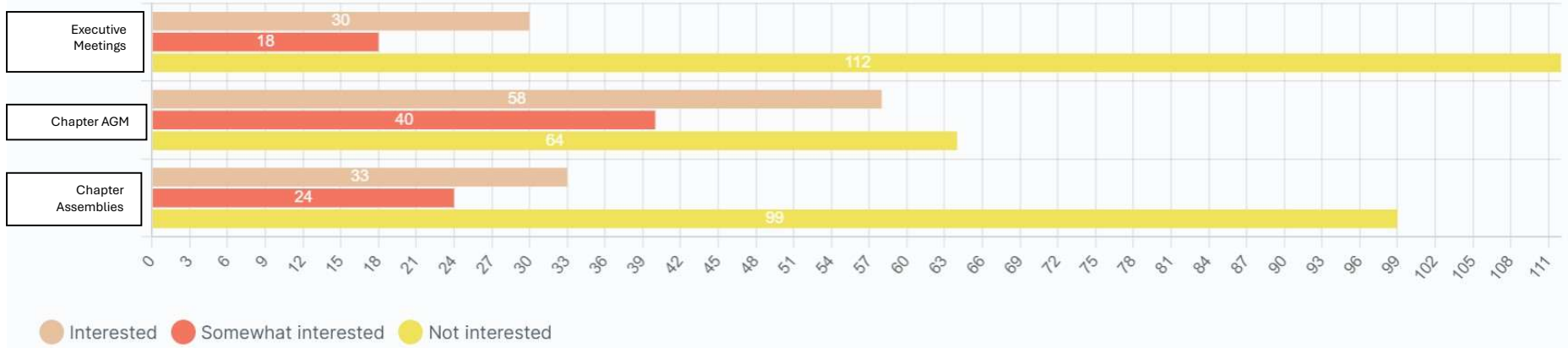

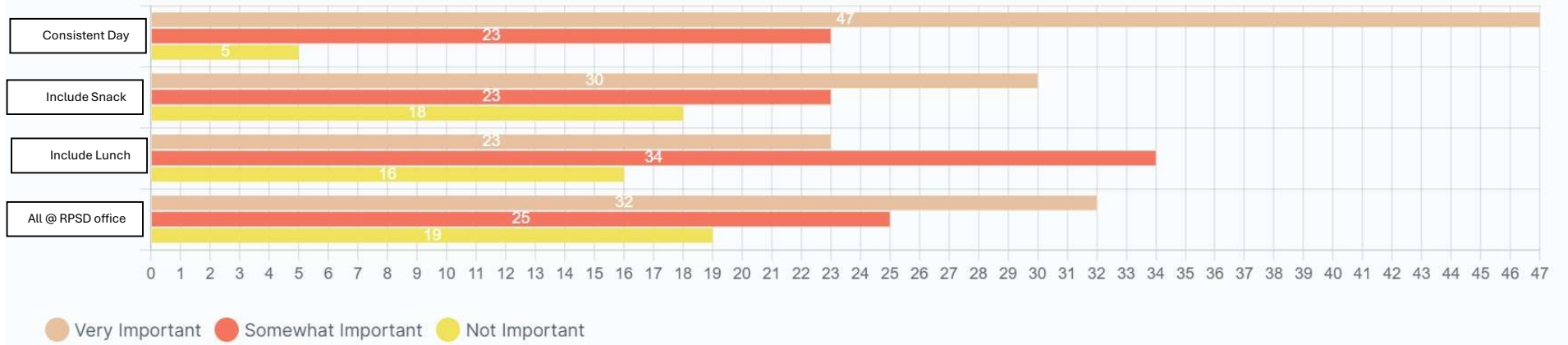
How interested are you in participating in these Recreational Activities?

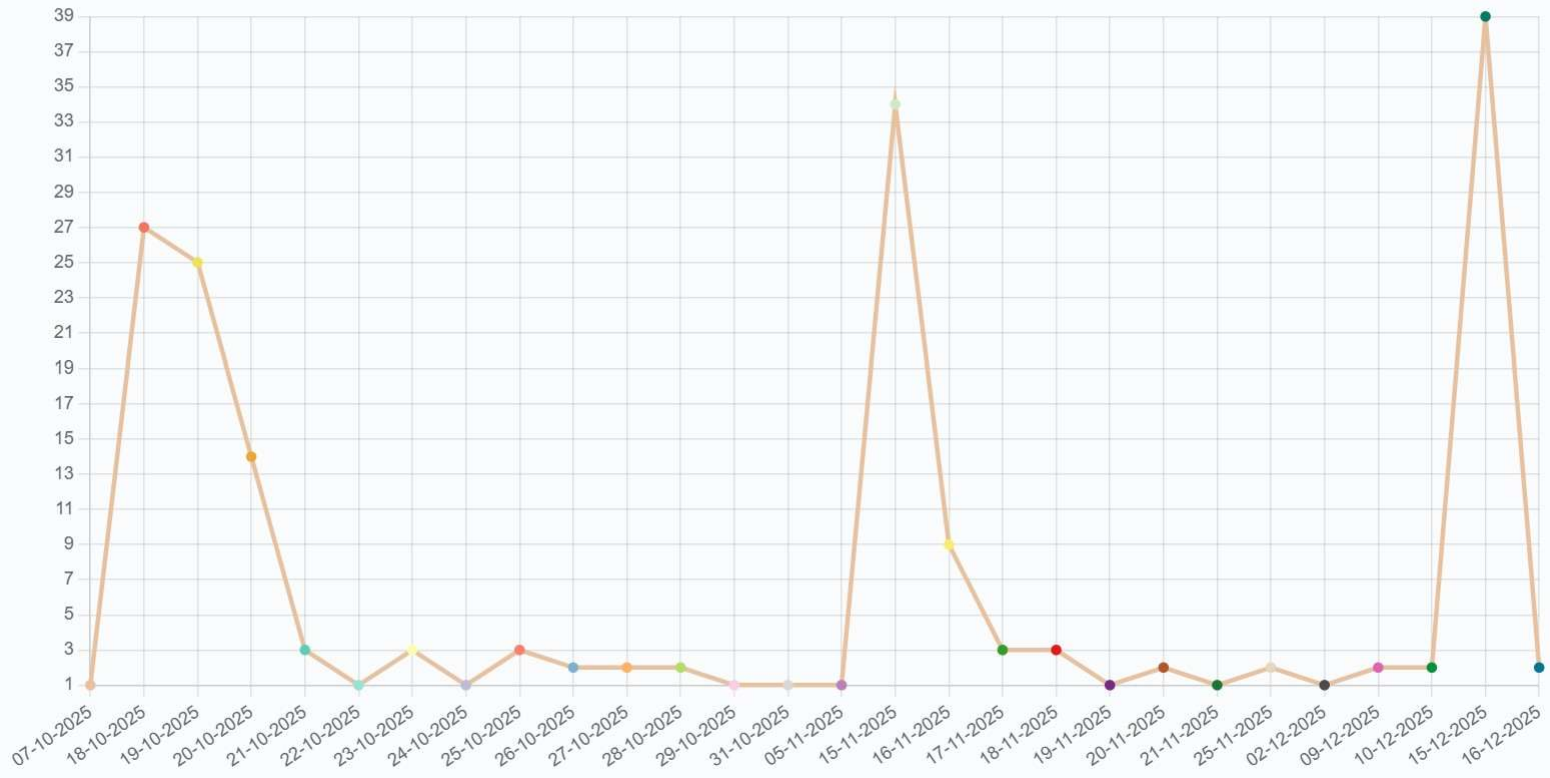


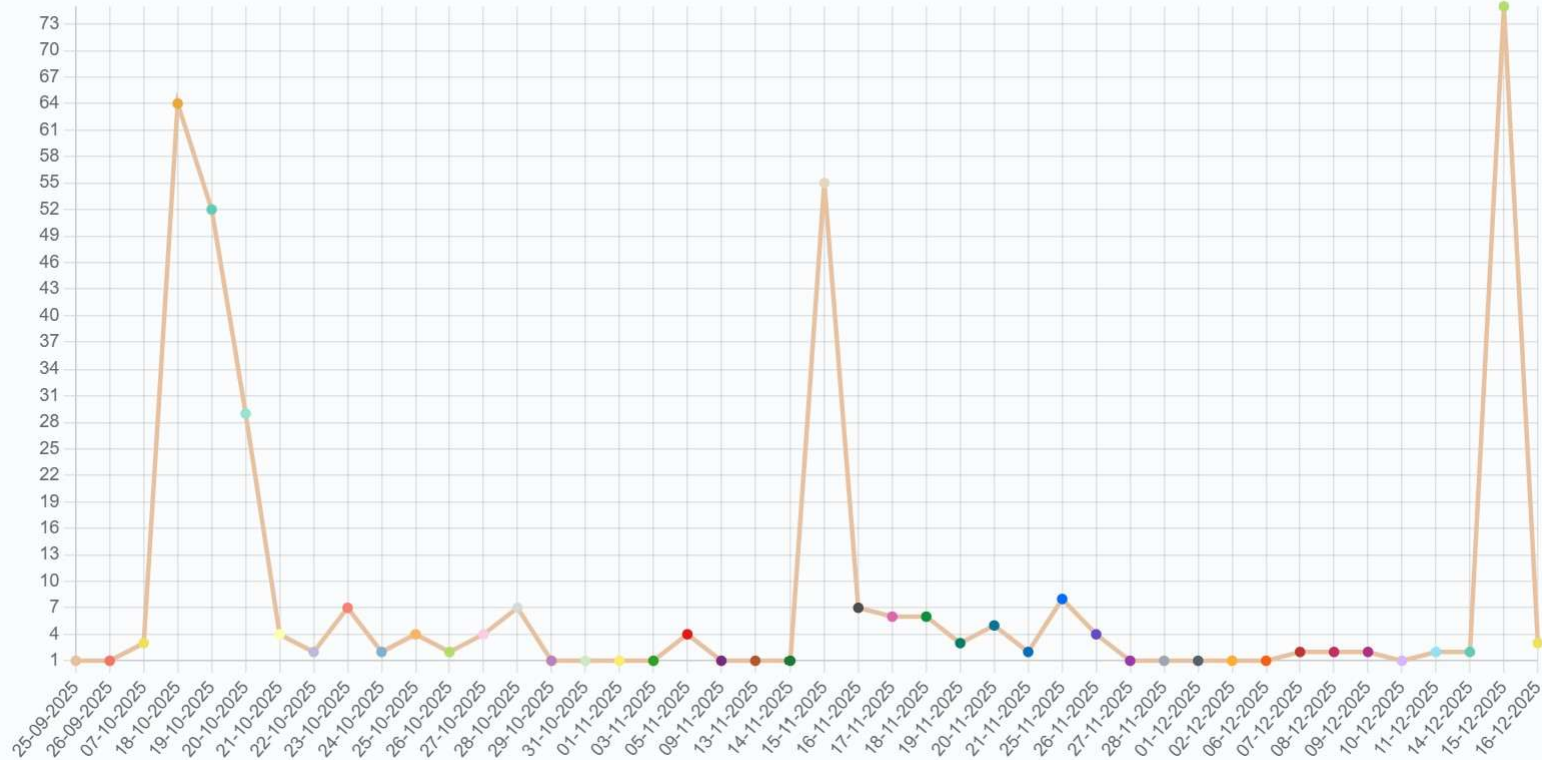
How interested are you in attending these STS Regina Chapter Meetings?
