Thursday September 18, 2025: Historical Regina Schools

The assembly will be held in the Ron Mitchell Room on September 18, 2025, with the start at 1:30 pm. This assembly will also include a brief business meeting where the Proposed 2025-2026 Regina Chapter Budget will be presented, discussed and voted on.

The guest speaker, Don Black, will speak on: Where was Regina's first school? What's the story behind the Graton School - Regina's first Catholic school? Join Don Black for answers to these questions and many more during a fascinating overview of school design in Regina during the last 143 years.



Don Black, a proud 1963 graduate of Davin School, has shared presentations on Regina's architectural history to numerous groups in the city over the past 20 years. A committed volunteer, Don has served 10 years on Regina's Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee, and 10 years on the Warehouse District Committee, as well as several years as an instructor for the Lifelong Learning Centre.

Tour the Buffalo Pound Water Treatment Plant to gain a deeper understanding of the processes involved to supply more than 270,000 people in Regina, Moose Jaw and area with safe drinking water 24/7. See firsthand the improvements in the \$325 million renewal project. **Next at your pace, enjoy the natural beauty of Nicolle Flats Interpretive Area:** a marshland stroll down the boardwalk or a hike on the natural prairie grassland trails.
