
Come and have some fun singing, listening and dancing to music from the 70's and 80's.



Lake Diefenbaker irrigation project with Bob Halliday

Bob is former president of R. A. Halliday and Associates, a water resources engineering consultancy. He previously worked for Environment Canada and was director of Canada's National Hydrology Research Centre. He has served on several entities related to water issues between Canada and the United States and on the Prairie Provinces Water Board.

Bob is the vice-president of the Saskatchewan Environmental Society and past president of the Canadian Water Resources Association, Saskatchewan Branch.

Saskatchewan announced a major expansion of Lake Diefenbaker irrigation in July 2020. The project would consist of 200,000 ha of new irrigation and would be developed in three phases at a cost of \$4 billion. Since that time considerable engineering and other studies have been conducted but little of that work has been released to the public. The province is proceeding with Phase 1 for which initial cost estimates have doubled. There are many public policy, economic and environmental concerns with the proposed project. This session will provide background information on the South Saskatchewan River basin and provide a project update. Concerns with the project, including a recently released economic study, will be discussed.




