Spring Fling Dance Saturday, April 18th at the Serbian Club. Come and have some fun singing, listening and dancing to music from the 70's and 80's.



Join us for a free viewing of the acclaimed '**Singing Back the Buffalo**' by Cree Filmmaker, Tasha Hubbard! Tasha is a Cree award-winning filmmaker, a buffalo academic at the University of Alberta and buffalo activist. This 90 minute documentary features Indigenous visionaries, scientists and communities who are returning the buffalo to the North American Plains. With Blackfoot Elder Leroy Little Bear, Hubbard weaves the story of connections to buffalo and how their return to the Great Plains signals a turning point for Indigenous nations and a new era of sustainability and balance in nature. The Emma Stewart Resource Centre is providing related resource material to browse and to loan. The film also features the Buffalo Treaty first signed in 2014. Now over 40 first nations are signatories including many in Saskatchewan. Singing Back the Buffalo is produced in association with CBC and APTN among others.
