**GARBAGE & RECYCLING**

**WATER & SEWER**

Bills are sent out on the 1st of the month and DUE by the 15th. Make sure you:

- 1) Bring to the City Office, place in the back drop box, or pay online at [allpaid.com](http://allpaid.com)
- 4) Water will be shut off if not paid by the end of that month.

**COMPOST SITE**

This is located south of Crystal Valley. Please do not drive through Crystal Valley, follow the road. Only STICKS, BRUSH, and TREE LIMBS are allowed. NO LUMBER or GARBAGE. All leaves and other organic material, including grass clippings, should be placed on a pile east of the center for composting.

**SOME OF OUR ORDINANCES...**

**ORDINANCE #60**

...states that no unlicensed and/or junk vehicles may be parked on your property or on city streets. All vehicles must also be in running order even if licensed. This includes recreational vehicles, lawnmowers, etc.

**ORDINANCE #61**

...states that grass and weeds may not exceed 6 inches. Grass clippings are not to be mowed into the street or gutters. The cost for clean-up of grass clippings is \$50.00 an hour.

**ORDINANCE #74**

...states that all dogs/cats must be registered through the City. Dogs must be on a leash and have a current rabies tag. The Ordinance states only three dogs and/or three cats per residence. Invisible fences are not allowed.

**COUNTY ORDINANCE...FIRE RINGS**

Fire Rings may be used within city limits but only dry twigs and sticks may be burned. A fire ring can be no larger than 3 feet in diameter and flames cannot be higher than 3 feet. No unattended fires and fires only from 6:00 pm - 8:00 am. No daytime burning.

Call the Waseca County Sheriff or the local DNR to report anyone not following the regulations as this is a COUNTY ORDINANCE.

There is NO target practice or any other firing of guns allowed in City Limits, this INCLUDES the COMPOST SITE. This includes bow and arrow.
