We have agreed that at least 20% of any winnings will be given back to at least 1 boat in 11th-100th place by random boat draw, but you have to be present to win. SBL is designed as a team trail, but you want to fish alone, you can be a team of 1 with us.

We are very excited to partner with Fishing Chaos as our tournament platform. The benefits Fishing Chaos provide to you as an angler and to SBL are unmatched in the industry, the information and capabilities it puts at your fingertips far outweigh the cost. If you choose to subscribe, it will open a world of fishing opportunities and give you the ability to track current leaderboard standings, AOY points, live broadcasts, access to any tournament in the Fishing Chaos network and the list goes on! The Fishing Chaos app is free and we definitely encourage everyone to subscribe, but a subscription is not required to fish with Southern Bass League. SBL wants you to get the most bang for your bucks and this partnership brings a lot of BANG!

How much does it cost to fish and what do I get for my money?

Option 1: Upon full payment of \$950.00 (+ Fishing Chaos fees), you or your team will be:

Option 2: Pay half (\$475.00 + Fishing Chaos fee) at time of registration. Pay the remaining half (\$475.00 + 2.99% card fee) any time before March 15 2025 you or your team will be:

 - a. Each angler will receive SBL Merchandise.
 - b. Discounts for SBL members on various items provided by sponsors, as they come available.
 - c. Each member will get a vote in deciding which lakes we fish next year!!! (How many tournament trails let you do that?)
- 2) Guaranteed spot in the 5 tournament trail, brought to you by Southern Bass League.
 - a. **100% pay back** of all tournament fees, yep, you read it correctly, 100% payback!

Who's eligible to fish?

- 1) We feel that the 5-day off limits levels the playing field enough that we can fish against "pros" and "guides". With that being said, we say, come on!! Let's go fishing!!
- 2) Anyone under the age of 18, must be accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license and valid boat operator license (for your state) and a valid Alabama Fishing license.

Tournament rules
