Green Country Veterinary Hospital requires all 1st time guest of Tiny Town come in for a FREE doggie day care prior to their first overnight stay (minimum of 4 hours but welcome to stay full day).

This relieves anxiety from being in unfamiliar environment and assures your dog you will be back! While here, we will temperament test them to ensure they play well with other dogs and will be a good fit for Tiny Town! They will also have one on one time with our staff so they are familiar with us! During their stay in Tiny Town at GCVH, your pet will have the option to play with other dogs all day or to go into their own suite and play alone!

Please read and fill out our tiny town boarding agreement & bring vaccination records on 1st day of doggie day care.



GREEN COUNTRY VETERINARY HOSPITAL TINY TOWN BOARDING AGREEMENT

If your pet becomes ill or if the state of the pet's health otherwise requires professional attention, the Kennel, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of our veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the pet, and the expenses thereof shall be paid by Owner.

- We feed IVET canine maintenance while your pet is here boarding with us unless you bring their own food. If your pet is on a therapeutic diet please bring your own diet or we can add a bag to your charges if we supply that type of food.
- Please take all blankets, toys, collars and leashes with you. We will provide our own. We have a wide variety of leashes, blankets and toys here to use, this helps us ensure that nothing is lost or destroyed.
- GCVH will send photos of your pet to you if a valid cell phone number is provided. We will use and post these photos on social media unless requested otherwise. Be sure and tell the receptionist so a note can be made if you do not wish for the photos to be used.
- All dogs must be up to date on vaccines prior to boarding with us. This includes annual DHLPP, Rabies, semiannual Bordetella (given every six months no exceptions), and Canine Influenza.
- Is in good health and has not been ill with any communicable condition in the last 30 days
- Has not harmed or shown aggressive/threatening behavior toward any person or other dog(s).
- This contract shall be in force for this and all future boarding at Green Country Veterinary Hospital.
- Owner specifically represents to Kennel that the pet has not been exposed to rabies, distemper, parvo virus, feline leukemia or other contagious diseases within a thirty day period prior to boarding.

- If your pet is found to have fleas or ticks while staying with us they will be treated with what our doctor sees fit for an **additional charge**.
- There is a Fee of \$6.00 per day of boarding for any medications or supplements brought in with your pet.
- Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Contract, or the breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to this Contract, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgment upon the award rendered by an arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitrator shall, as part of this award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the costs of such arbitration and reasonable attorneys' fees of the prevailing party.
- Owner agrees that the pet shall not leave GCVH until all charges are paid in full.
- GCVH will not be responsible for any items lost or destroyed. Items left past 30 days will be donated or discarded.
- Owner is responsible and will be charged for any damage pet(s) inflict upon people, **property** or other pets (inclusive of pets boarding together at owner's request).
- I preauthorize this form to be used for one year from today's date
- I authorize GCVH to administer anxiety medication if Dr deems pet is in need of such medication. I understand I will be given a call to inform me of such treatment and there will be a \$6.00 charge per day for administration as well as a charge for the entire dosage. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

CPR / RESUSCITATION

In the event of a medical emergency, it is important that we are able to provide CPR/Resuscitation if necessary to save your pet's life. Please acknowledge the risks associated, and please initial next to the option you choose in case of emergency.

Important Acknowledgements regarding CPR:

- I understand that even if resuscitation is successful, my pet may suffer **brain damage, organ failure, poor quality of life, or death.**
- I acknowledge that outcomes cannot be guaranteed and that the veterinary team will act in their best medical judgment within the limits of my authorization.

Please choose ONE of the following options regarding CPR/Resuscitation

_____ **PROCEED WITH CPR**

I authorize cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in the event of cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. CPR may include chest compressions, intubation, assisted ventilation, emergency drugs, and other life-saving measures deemed appropriate by the attending veterinarian. I **understand and agree that CPR is billed at \$300 for the first 15 minutes**, with additional charges possible for continued resuscitation efforts, medications, emergency procedures, and hospitalization.

_____ **DNR- DO NOT RESUSCITATE**

I do **NOT** authorize CPR if my pet experiences cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. I understand that no resuscitative efforts will be made and that humane comfort measures may be provided.
