## 1. Market recognition

Homes that are built to the **ENERGY STAR for New Homes Standard** are awarded a nationally recognized ENERGY STAR label by the Government of Canada.



Did you know? 88% of Canadians recognize the ENERGY STAR symbol.

The ENERGY STAR symbol is more than a mark of energy efficiency; it's also a symbol of trust. As an ENERGY STAR builder, you may use the ENERGY STAR symbol in your advertising, on your website, on signage and in other promotional materials.

All active builders have access to **free ENERGY STAR marketing materials**. Builders are also **listed on Natural Resources Canada's website**, where
homebuyers can find energy-efficient
homebuilders in their area.

## 2. Program flexibility

The ENERGY STAR for New Homes program offers two flexible construction options for builders:

- **1. Performance path** Involves energy modelling the home using Natural Resources Canada's energy simulation software to confirm performance (or compliance).
- 2. Prescriptive path Includes several builder option packages based on provincial location. This option can be beneficial to tract builders who build numerous homes within a short time frame and want to build to the ENERGY STAR Standard as part of their base model or offer their customers energy efficiency upgrade packages.

## 3. Enhanced customer satisfaction

ENERGY STAR builders can provide customers with a certification that their home was carefully designed and built to be energy-efficient. This can save homeowners hundreds of dollars on their energy bills and improve their overall comfort and satisfaction.
