

Policy for Attending Lincoln Retreat

If more than the maximum capacity for the Lincoln Retreat register to attend, selection of attendees will be the following:

All members applying to attend the retreat will be reviewed to determine participation in the Guild with the following criteria:

Members must attend a minimum of five meetings in a year and qualify in at least **one** of the following:

1. Earn at least five (5) Community Service points (note: see key for item points below),
 - a. For the January Retreat, look to the prior year,
 - b. For the July Retreat, look to the past six (6) months.
2. Chair a committee or actively participate as a member of a committee,
3. Be an Officer of the Guild,
4. Make two Opportunity Quilt visits (or one out-of-town visit)

If a registrant has attended at least five meetings and qualified in at least one of the other above participation opportunities, they are placed in the pool of members eligible to be in the lottery. From the eligible members a lottery is drawn to determine who will be on the wait list.

If eligible participating members have all been selected and there are still seats available, a lottery of non-participating members will be used to determine participation in the retreat.
