

## “Between the Lines”-48” by 60” long, Great for Jelly Rolls



- Use a jelly roll or 37, 2 ½ wide strips across width of fabric. Piece the strips together along long edges. Trim both sides even. Make a cut across the pieced strips 5” from each side.
- Trim selvages from 7 remaining strips and cut into 8 ½ inch strips, (four pieces from each strip). Save the scraps from each strip. Piece together 7 of the 8 ½ inch strips to construct the vertical insert pieces, (makes four).
- Make 4 vertical insert pieces by joining scraps together, staggering seams, (see photo). Repeat for the other 2 vertical pieces. Join the vertical inserts to either side of the center body of top, matching seams to those of the center body. Attach the 5” strips to the vertical insert, (match fabric strips up with those in the center), trim inserts at the top and bottom edges of quilt.
- Quilt and bind.
