DIVIDE & CONQUER QUILT

FINISHED SIZE: 45.5" X 60"
SKILL LEVEL: CONFIDENT BEGINNER





SUPPLIES

1 LAYER CAKE (10" SQUARES)

Batting - a piece slightly larger than the top*

Backing - 4 1/4 yards*

Thread to match*

* Not included in fabric pack

Read instructions thoroughly before starting.

Do not prewash fabrics. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric.

PREPARATION

Choose three 10" squares, making sure there is contrast between the fabrics. Repeat to make a total of twelve stacks.


INSTRUCTIONS

CUTTING

Layer one stack. Cut according to the diagram below. Diagram 1. Repeat with the remaining eleven stacks, keeping the cut stacks separate.

SEWING BLOCKS


Each stack will make three blocks. You will use all three fabrics in each block. Choose one fabric for the 4" \times 6" units, another for the 4" \times 4" units and the final fabric for the 2" x 9 1/2" unit. Diagram 2.

Sew the blocks together according to the diagram below. Sew a 4" unit to the right side of the $4" \times 6"$ unit. Sew the remaining 4" unit to the left side of the $4" \times 6"$ unit. Sew the 2" \times 9 1/2" unit between them. The blocks will measure 9" \times 9 1/2" unfinished. Diagram 3.



PIECING THE TOP

Layout blocks five across and seven down. You will only use thirty-five blocks. Note: The extra block can be your label for the back of your quilt. Sew the blocks into rows

MAKING THE BINDING

From the remaining six 10" squares, cut four 2 1/2" strips from each squares. Sew short ends together to make one long strip. Press in half. If you choose not to do this then purchase 1/2 yard of fabric for the binding. You FINISHING THE QUILT

Layer the top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind in the preferred method.
