UPDATE -I wrote this weeks ago and the situation is getting much more intense and will continue to be as we head into April. No one can predict but models for NM show we will have 526 deaths and not be safe until 1 July. AZ shows we will have 1,380 deaths and not be safe until June 13th., CO- 2,135 deaths, safe by May 27th, UT- 586 deaths, safe by July 9th.
