Rally Requirements for Rallymasters

3 Months Before Rally

Prepare a rally teaser to be put in the newsletter to generate interest in your rally. Tell generally what you have planned. This teaser should be provided to both the VP/Wagonmaster and the Newsletter Editor at least three months in advance (for purposes of printing in the newsletter).

2 Months Before Rally

Provide a day by day schedule -- list of planned activities the attendees will experience on your rally.

Include places you will visit, names of restaurants, and areas you will visit by car, etc.

Keep track of attendees.

Members planning to attend your rally should contact you at least 4 weeks before the rally so that you have a head count for buying supplies and making plans.

Contact Attendees

A few weeks before the rally, email your final schedule to each attendee with any additional details they need to know. Everyone understands that your list of activities may be altered due to weather and availability. It's also helpful to bring extra copies of your schedule for those who didn't bring theirs or who "never got it".

If you want to drive, you can find parking at Freemont St. Experience Parking or the large parking lot at the D Hotel and Casino. The walk is .02 miles to the restaurant. This is a lot of walking wear comfortable shoes and clothes.

The Neon Sign Museum at 770 Las Vegas Blvd N, Las Vegas isn't just a tourist trap. It showcases some of the most iconic signs that have been displayed throughout the city. Highlighting the rich Las Vegas history. Guided tours, immersive shows and events are only a few of the activities available at

this 3-acre museum. If you are an avid photographer and always looking for that "one shot," check out the Photo Walk, this allows you to bring in your equipment and focus on finding that perfect photo. Not only are the 200 plus signs a highlight of the museum, but the visitor center is a mid-Century modern design using atomic, and space-age shapes by architect Paul Revere Williams, making this stop a must-see.

The Mob Museum-300 Stewart Ave, Las Vegas, NV 89101

(Parking on site) -Learn about the birth of the Mob and how law enforcement caught them through interactive exhibits and artifacts.

Located just a few steps away from Fremont Street inside a restored 1933 Las Vegas courthouse.

Exhibitions connect both the academic community and the public with artifacts, digital records, and educational resources. Check out the Crime Lab Experience, a Prohibition-era world, and Mob's Greatest Hits.

Antelope Canyon (this must be pre-booked by you) and Horseshoe Bend (all day trip)

Friday March 4th- Pack a Lunch- bring your national senior park pass **7:30am**- **Hikers Departure for the Valley of Fire** (arrive 8:45)- Hiking the Seven Wonders Loop to the Fire Wave and White Domes.3.2 miles, 2hrs moderate. You can go to the wave and return for a shorter hike to petroglyphs. Atal Rock, slot canyon .01mile.

8:30am- Departure for Valley of Fire on your own

If you are not hiking-(it's 45mins from Valley of Fire to Lunch in Overton (3 choices- 1. Sugars bar & food, 309 S Moapa Valley Blvd, 2. La Fonda Mexican food, 461 S Moapa Valley Blvd, 3. Inside Scoop Deli & ice cream.

12:00 Picnic Lunch @ location to be determined

Afternoon-St Thomas Ghost Town -Walk among Nevada's own Atlantis-a ghost town that was underwater over 60 yrs. This former Mormon settlement is reemerging from the receding waters of Lake Mead. Watch video https://www.nps.gov/lake/learn/nature/st-thomas-nevada.htm, Loop is a flat 2 miles.

Directions: From the Valley of Fire turn left from the visitor's center go east on Vallely of Fire Rd., right on Hwy 169 go thru Overton Lake Meade Fee Station (bring your park pass). Take an immediate left on old St Thomas Rd (it turns into a dirt road) to the Historic St Thomas Trail Head. Loop is 2.5 miles or go as far as you like.
