Alvirne High School Friends of Music awards nonrenewable scholarships to Alvirne seniors who are active members of the Alvirne choral/instrumental music program. A minimum of three years of active participation is required as well as an acceptance into a college with an interest in music. Interested candidates will be attending at least one course in the same calendar year the scholarship is awarded. The scholarship will be awarded based on:

- Music Program Involvement and Commitment
- Music Leadership
- Music Community Service
- Academics
- Enrollment in a higher education music program

Our goal is to award scholarships to qualified participants. The amount will be determined by available funds. The scholarship will be awarded to a student entering a music program with a focus on one of the following: Education, Performance, Technology, Business.
