What don't we have in Australia?

All our fireflies belong to the one subfamily (Luciolinae) which is the only group of fireflies known from Australia New Guinea and the Pacific.

We do not have the giant glow worm *Lamprigera* here. It is a great attraction for naturalists overseas, it is a larviform female and huge by firefly standards.

Although you might see lovely pictures of various American fireflies especially *Photuris* and *Photinus* the two most common genera, we do not have them here either.
