



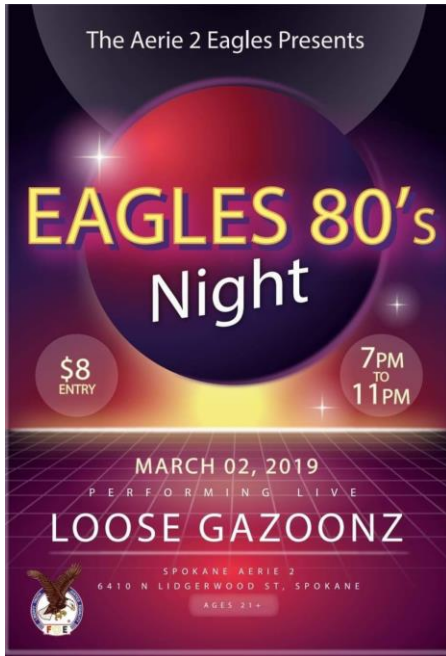

FOOD WORKER PERMIT LAW

WAC 246-217-010

Definitions:

(5) "Food service worker" means an individual who works (or intends to work) with or without pay in a food service establishment and handles unwrapped or unpackage food or who may contribute to the transmission of infectious diseases through the nature of his/her contact with food products and/or equipment and facilities.

(6) "Food worker card" means a food and beverage service workers' permit as required under chapter 69.06 RCW.

SPOKANE REGIONAL HEALTH DISTRICT

To apply for a Food Worker Card

Option #1: Online

All food employees in Spokane County who handle unwrapped foods or beverages are required to hold a current Washington State Food Worker Card. Food worker cards are \$10.00. To obtain a card, you must take a course and successfully complete a test covering the course material.

These rules apply to any and all volunteers. The Eagles trustees and staff are just trying to follow the rules and laws. They are not trying to destroy anything. 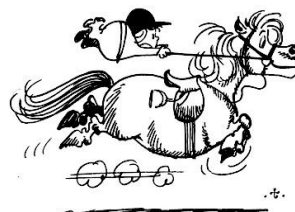
