Hand & Foot

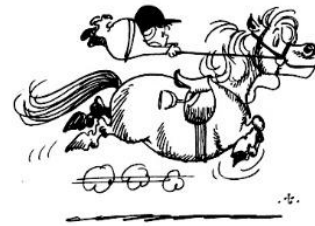

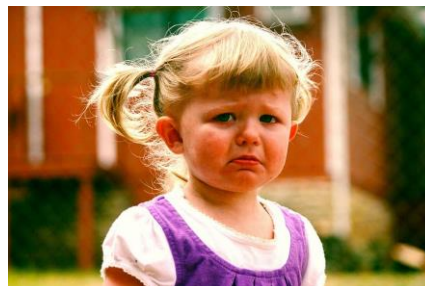
