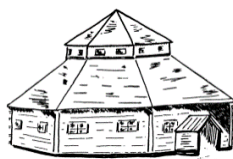

General Campground Information

Campsites: Campsite sites without power are **\$35** per night and **\$70** for power.

Check-in/Check-out time: The check-in time is 2:00 PM, and the check-out time is 11:00 AM. Failure to vacate the campsite by noon on the scheduled departure day may result in additional fees being charged by the Fairgrounds or the towing of the vehicle at the owners' expense.

Hours of Operation/Quiet Hours: During the high season, the Fair Office operates from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Hours may vary during shoulder seasons. Quiet hours are observed from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. We kindly request that guests refrain from loud talking, playing music, or creating other disruptive noise during these hours. Additionally, we ask guests not to use generators between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

Reservations: Camping sites cannot be reserved ahead of time; all sites are first come first served. Payment may be made in person during Fairgrounds office hours. For late-night walk-ins, please complete the form and place your payment in the night drop located at the Fairgrounds office.

Reservations are restricted to a maximum of 7 nights within any 30-day period.

Pet Policy: Pets must remain on a leash at all times. Please promptly clean up after your pet.

Trash Policy: Pack in and pack out, please leave no trace. Ensure all waste, including food scraps are properly packed out to maintain cleanliness and avoid interactions with wildlife. Please refrain from dumping gray water or any other fluids onto the ground.

Vehicle Regulations: Adhere to speed limits and traffic patterns while navigating within the campground. Park your vehicle only in designated areas, and avoid obstructing roads or pathways.

Campfire Regulations: Campfires are prohibited.

Fireworks and Firearms: The use of fireworks and firearms are prohibited within the campground, ensuring the safety of all visitors and preventing potential hazards.
