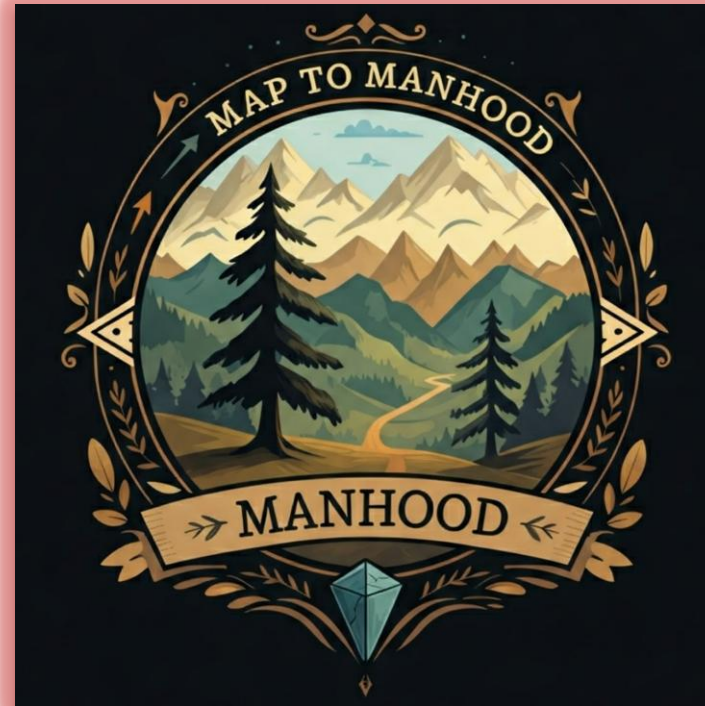

A LEADER & MENTOR	☐ Joshua 1:16-18 — "And they answered Joshua, "All that you have commanded us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go. Just as we obeyed Moses in all things, so we will obey you. Only may the Lord your God be with you, as he was with Moses! Whoever rebels against your commandment and disobeys your words, whatever you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and courageous."

A LEADER & MENTOR	□ 1 Corinthians 4:16-17 — "I urge you, then, be imitators of me. That is why I sent you Timothy, my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, to remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach them everywhere in every church."
A LEADER & MENTOR	□ 1 Timothy 1-2 — "Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope, To Timothy, my true child in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord."
A LEADER & MENTOR	□ 1 Timothy 1:3-4 — "remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith."
A LEADER & MENTOR	□ 2 Timothy 1:3-7 — "I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy. I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands, for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control."
A LEADER & MENTOR	□ 1 Kings 19:19-21 — "So he departed from there and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen in front of him, and he was with the twelfth. And he returned from following him and took the yoke of oxen and sacrificed them and boiled their flesh with the yokes of the oxen and gave it to the people, and they ate. And the two of them made a covenant before the Lord. David remained at Horesh, and Jonathan went home."

And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.' So take heart, men, for I have faith in God that it will be exactly as I have been told. But we must run aground on some island."

When he came and saw the grace of God, he was glad, and he exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast purpose, for he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord. So Barnabas went to Tarsus to look for Saul, and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. For a whole year they met with the church and taught a great many people. And in Antioch the disciples were first called Christians."

A LEADER & MENTOR -> Influence -> Communicate	☐ Ephesians 4:29 — "Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.""
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Influence -> Communicate	☐ Proverbs 25:15 — ""With patience a ruler may be persuaded, and a soft tongue will break a bone."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Influence -> Communicate	☐ Exodus 4:11-16 — "And the LORD said to him, "Who gave man his mouth? Or who makes the mute or the deaf, the sighted or the blind? Is it not I, the LORD? Now go! I will help you as you speak, and I will teach you what to say." But Moses replied, "Please, Lord, send someone else." Then the anger of the LORD burned against Moses, and He said, "Is not Aaron the Levite your brother? I know that he can speak well, and he is now on his way to meet you. When he sees you, he will be glad in his heart. You are to speak to him and put the words in his mouth. I will help both of you to speak, and I will teach you what to do. He will speak to the people for you. He will be your spokesman, and it will be as if you were God to him."

Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Stewardship	□ 1 Corinthians 14:1-2 — "This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Stewardship	□ 1 Corinthians 9:17 — "For if I do this of my own will, I have a reward, but if not of my own will, I am still entrusted with a stewardship."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Stewardship	□ Ephesians 3:1-2 — "For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles— assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for you,"

And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

A LEADER & MENTOR -> Servitude	☐ John 13:5 — "Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Servitude	☐ Galatians 5:13 — "For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Decisive	☐ 2 John 1:9-11 — "Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house or give him any greeting, for whoever greets him takes part in his wicked works."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Decisive	☐ James 4:8 — "Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Decisive	☐ Joshua 1:10-11 — "And Joshua commanded the officers of the people, "Pass through the midst of the camp and command the people, 'Prepare your provisions, for within three days you are to pass over this Jordan to go in to take possession of the land that the Lord your God is giving you to possess.'
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ Proverbs 16:22 — "Good sense is a fountain of life to him who has it, but the instruction of fools is folly."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ 2 Chronicles 1:7-13 — "In that night God appeared to Solomon, and said to him, "Ask what I shall give you."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ Proverbs 24:5 — "A wise man is full of strength, and a man of knowledge enhances his might,"
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ Exodus 18:21 — "Moreover, look for able men from all the people, men who fear God, who are trustworthy and hate a bribe, and place such men over the people as chiefs of thousands, of hundreds, of fifties, and of tens."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ 1 Samuel 23:10-12 — "Then David said, "O Lord, the God of Israel, your servant has surely heard that Saul seeks to come to Keilah, to destroy the city on my account. Will the men of Keilah surrender me into his hand? Will Saul come down, as your servant has heard? O Lord, the God of Israel, please tell your servant." And the Lord said, "He will come down." Then David said, "Will the men of Keilah surrender me and my men into the hand of Saul?" And the Lord said, "They will surrender you."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	☐ 2 Samuel 5:22-25 — "And the Philistines came up yet again and spread out in the Valley of Rephaim. And when David inquired of the Lord, he said, "You shall not go up; go around to their rear, and come against them opposite the balsam trees. And when you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the balsam trees, then rouse yourself, for then the Lord has gone out before you to strike down the army of the Philistines." And David did as the Lord commanded him, and struck down the Philistines from Geba to Gezer."

A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	□ 2 Samuel 8:15-18 — "So David reigned over all Israel. And David administered justice and equity to all his people. Joab the son of Zeruiah was over the army, and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud was recorder, and Zadok the son of Ahitub and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar were priests, and Seraiah was secretary, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and the Pelethites, and David's sons were priests."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	□ Nehemiah 2:17 — "Then I said to them, "You see the trouble we are in, how Jerusalem lies in ruins with its gates burned. Come, let us build the wall of Jerusalem, that we may no longer suffer derision."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	□ Nehemiah 6:2-3 — "Sanballat and Geshem sent to me, saying, "Come and let us meet together at Hakkephirim in the plain of Ono." But they intended to do me harm. And I sent messengers to them, saying, "I am doing a great work and I cannot come down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and come down to you?"
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Competence	□ Nehemiah 6:15 — "So the wall was finished on the twenty-fifth day of the month Elul, in fifty-two days."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ 1 Peter 1:13 — "Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ 1 Peter 1:20-21 — "He was foreknown before the foundation of the world but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you who through him are believers in God, who raised him from the dead and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Luke 6:47-49 — "Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like: he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Acts 1:6-8 — "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Proverbs 16:3 — "Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Proverbs 16:9 — "The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Proverbs 21:5 — "The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, but everyone who is hasty comes only to poverty."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	□ Proverbs 19:21 — "Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the Lord that will stand."

A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	☐ Luke 14:28-30 — "For which of you, desiring to build a tower, does not first sit down and count the cost, whether he has enough to complete it? Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.'"
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	☐ Luke 14:31-33 — "Or what king, going out to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and deliberate whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? And if not, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks for terms of peace. So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Vision	☐ 1 Timothy 1:5 — "The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ Deuteronomy 6:7 — "You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ Titus 1:7-9 — "For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ 1 Corinthians 9:27 — "But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ Luke 12:11-12 — "When you are brought before synagogues, rulers, and authorities, do not worry about how to defend yourselves or what to say. For at that time the Holy Spirit will teach you what you should say."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ John 14:26 — "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have told you."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ 1 Timothy 2:11-12 — "A woman must learn in quietness and full submissiveness. I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; she is to remain quiet."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ Isaiah 28:26 — "For his God instructs and teaches him properly."
A LEADER & MENTOR -> Teacher	☐ 1 Kings 8:36 — "so that You may teach them the good way in which they should walk."
