P.D.R. Disabled Youth Deer Hunt

An authentic South Dakota hunting experience and free guided hunt for physically-challenged and wheelchair-enabled adolescents ages 12 to 18.

Friday - September 16, 2022

- Introduction session with host Dean Rasmussen at the Clark Hunting Lodge
- Afternoon target shooting (rifles and shooting supplies available)
- Evening cook-out
- Overnight accommodations provided

Saturday - September 17, 2022

- Pre-Dawn coffee and rolls at the meeting lodge
- Each hunter and their required guardian are escorted by guides to the field in separate 4x4 vehicles to custom, ground-level deer blinds and assisted in the taking of one deer
- Noon lunch-break and return to blinds if necessary
- Evening banquet and overnight accommodations provided

Dean Rasmussen and his neighbors near Clark, South Dakota, will provide access to prime deer hunting land for up to ten youths who have physical limitations including the wheelchair-enabled.

Hunters receive a free guided hunting adventure on private land September 16 - 18, 2022.

Participants must:

- Be accompanied by a guardian
- Have transport to/from Clark, SD
 - Take the South Dakota Youth Hunter Safety course
- Have a valid Youth Big Game deer license (available at: www.sdgifp.info)
- Wear at least one item of orange colored apparel

The PDR Hunt will provide and require a signed waiver of responsibility typical of the type used at hunting lodges throughout South Dakota.
