The PDR Deer Hunt for disabled youth is looking for hunters. This hunt is conducted specifically for youth 12 to 18 years of age with any disability. Participants will receive an all-expenses paid hunting weekend adventure in mid-September. Included for both hunter and one parent or guardian are: meals/lodging for two nights and the venison processing of one white-tail doe as well as access to: firearms, ammunition, targets, prime private hunting land, special ground-level deer blinds with ramps and hard surface floors to accommodate wheelchairs, individual hunting guides, transportation to/from the field.
