## FINAL CLUB MEETING IS MAY 12

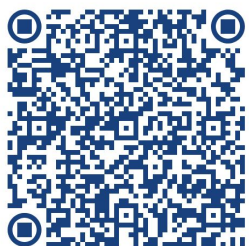

## STATE-OF-THE-ART STEVENSON ATHLETIC COMPLEX OPENS

UCS school and district officials unveiled the newly constructed Stevenson Athletic Complex, located at Metro Parkway and Dodge Park, on April 6. The new Stevenson facility features baseball and softball turf fields and adjacent grandstands, scoreboards and press boxes, as well as an 8-court tennis facility, restrooms and concessions. Similar new complexes have also been unveiled this spring at UCS's Eisenhower and Ford high schools. The improvements were funded through the 2023 voter-approved \$500 million UCS Safety and Success Bond Issue.
